- He always \_\_\_\_\_(to invite) his friends to his birthday party.
- She \_\_\_\_\_ (to wash) her car once a week.

- I / you/ they/ we + V
- My friends live in a big house
- I wake up every morning



• I \_\_\_\_\_ (to visit) my friend every week

• We \_\_\_\_\_(to go) for a walk every day.

• They \_\_\_\_\_( live) in a small flat/

- He /she/it + does not +
  V

• I don not use my car

She does not do any sport

• You do not like tennis


