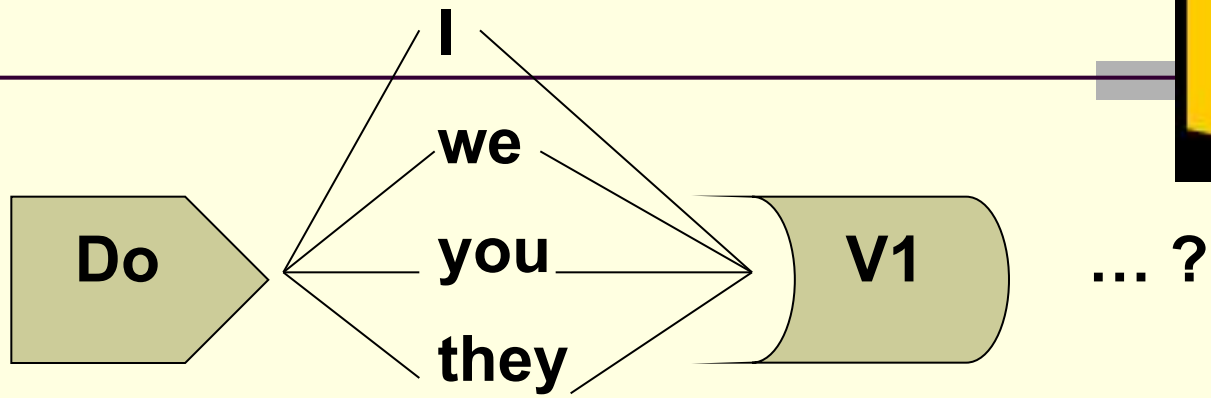
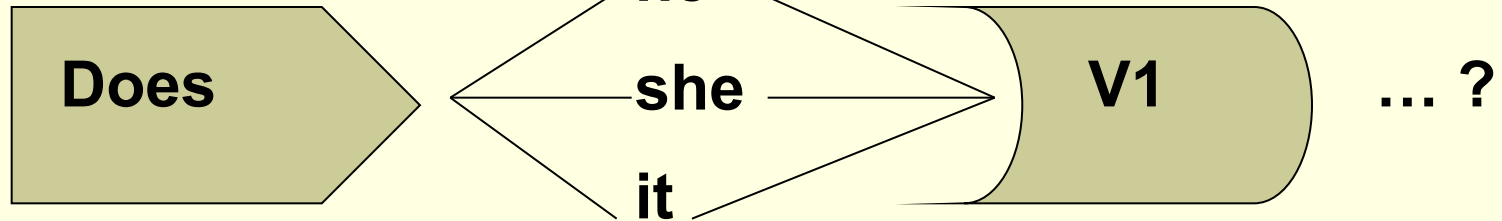
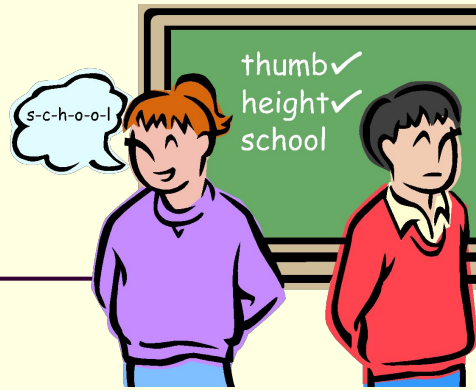


Present Simple Tense. Yes / No Questions and Answers

**Does** the boy **ask** a lot of questions?

Yes, he does.

No, he doesn't.

Does a mouse *build* a house?

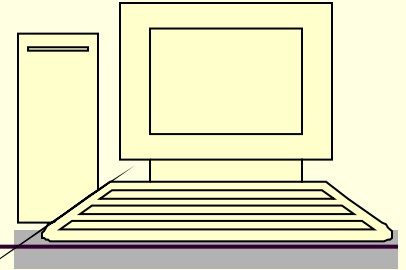
Does a crocodile *like* other animals?

Does an anaconda *live* in Britain?

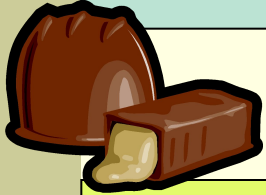
Do bears *ride* a bike?

Yes, she does. She plays the guitar.

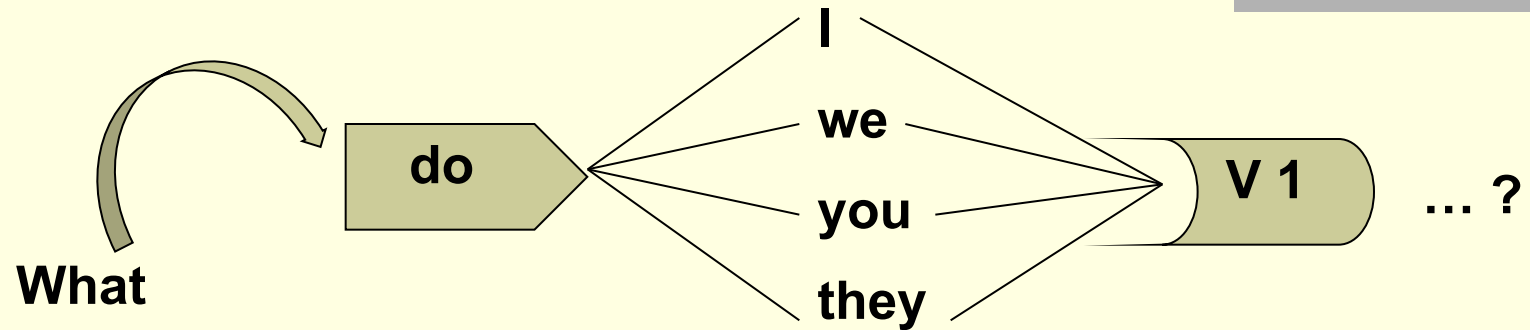
Yes, we do. We often go on picnics.

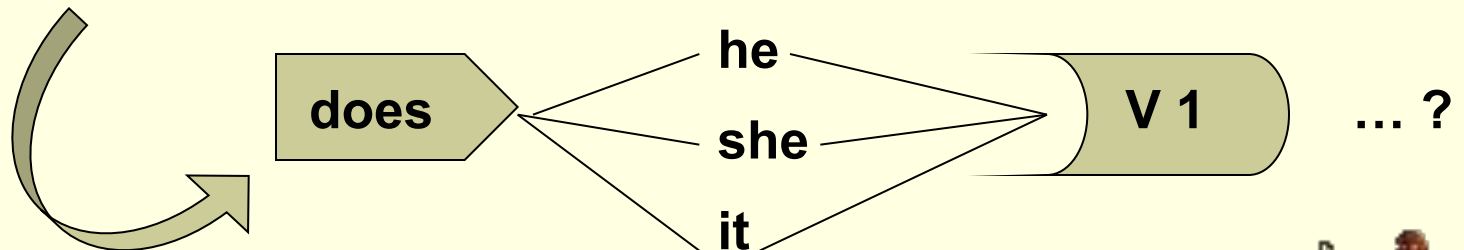
