Tourists like taking this busses because they can have a nice vew of the city from the upper deck.

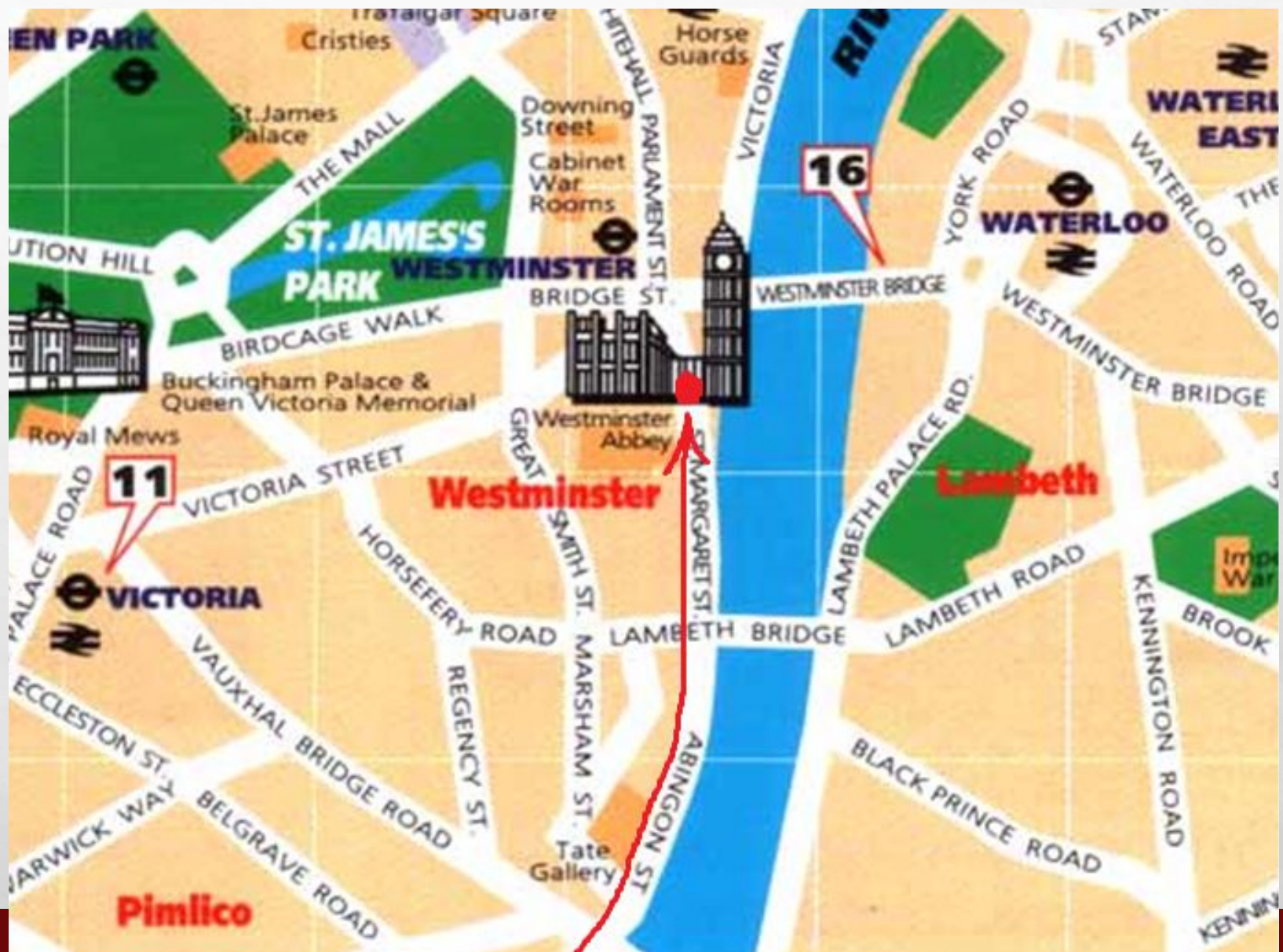


BLACK CAB

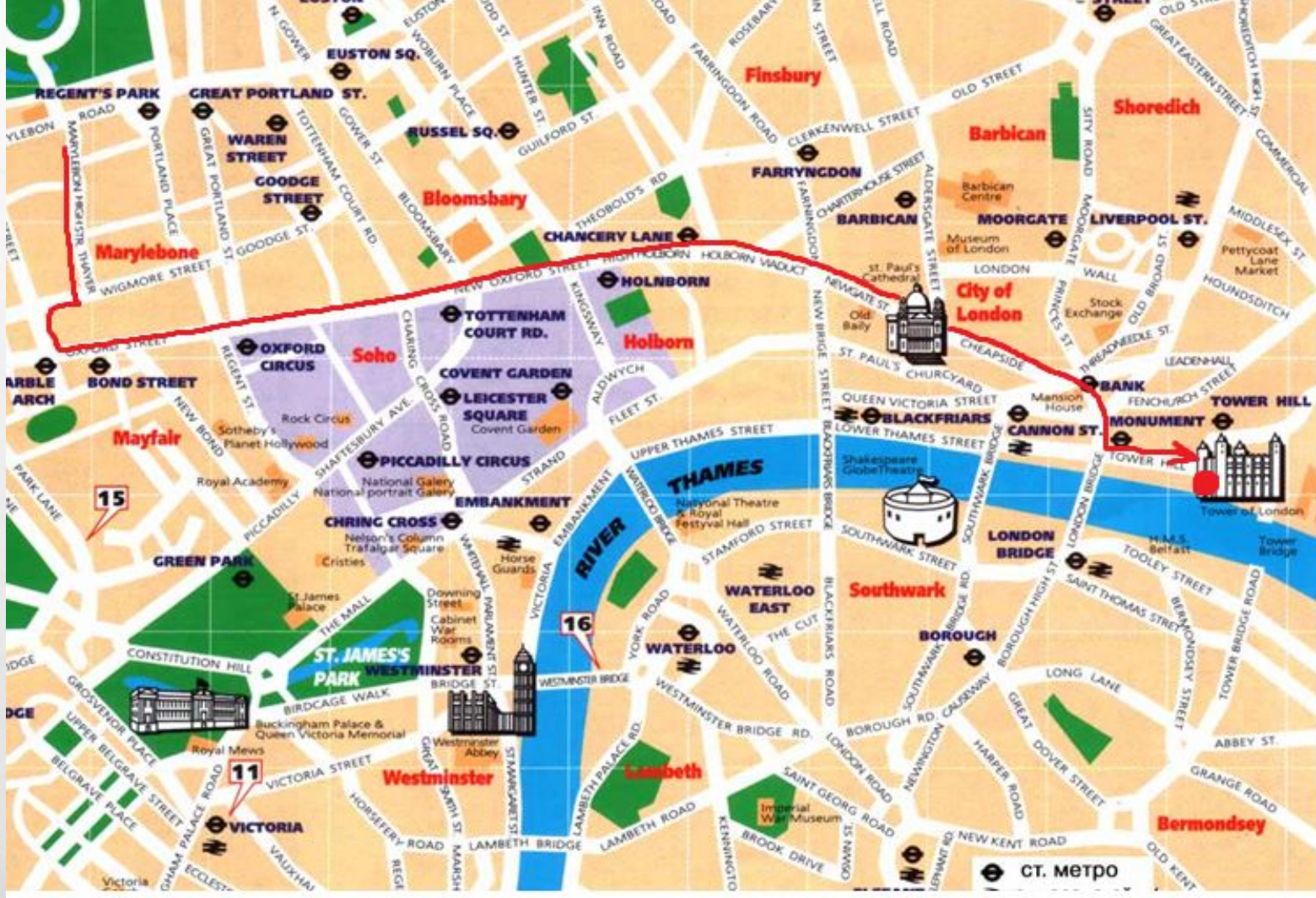
