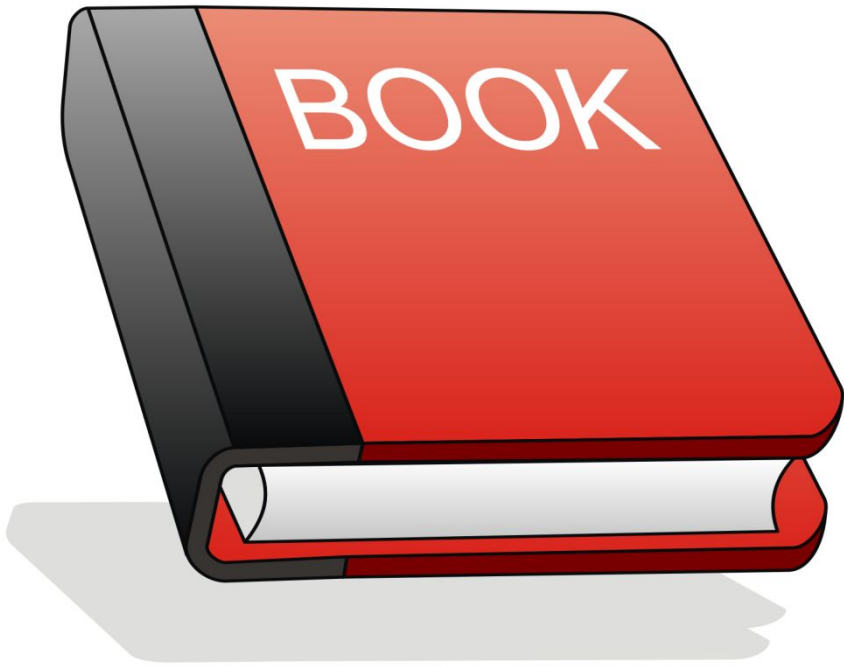

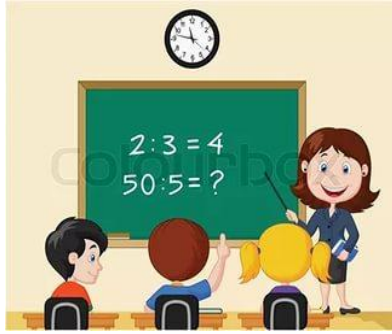

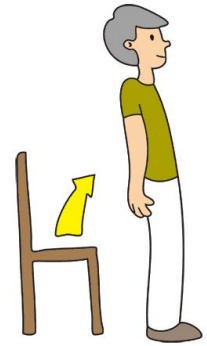

The school day in England
