






The history of football

At first you could play with your hands and feet. The key date is 1863, when a single set of rules was first adopted. Here among fans of football there was a


split. The most important was the decision to bar playing with hands. Spagned with this, other became the ancestors rugby.




Popular footballers or legends?

It took him a long time to became «an idol» of English football. David started his career as a simple player of English team. He was famous for exact passes, that gave a lot of opportunities for scoring.




Wayne Rooney

In February 2003, Rooney had his debut in the match Australia – England and as a result he became the youngest player in the English team.




