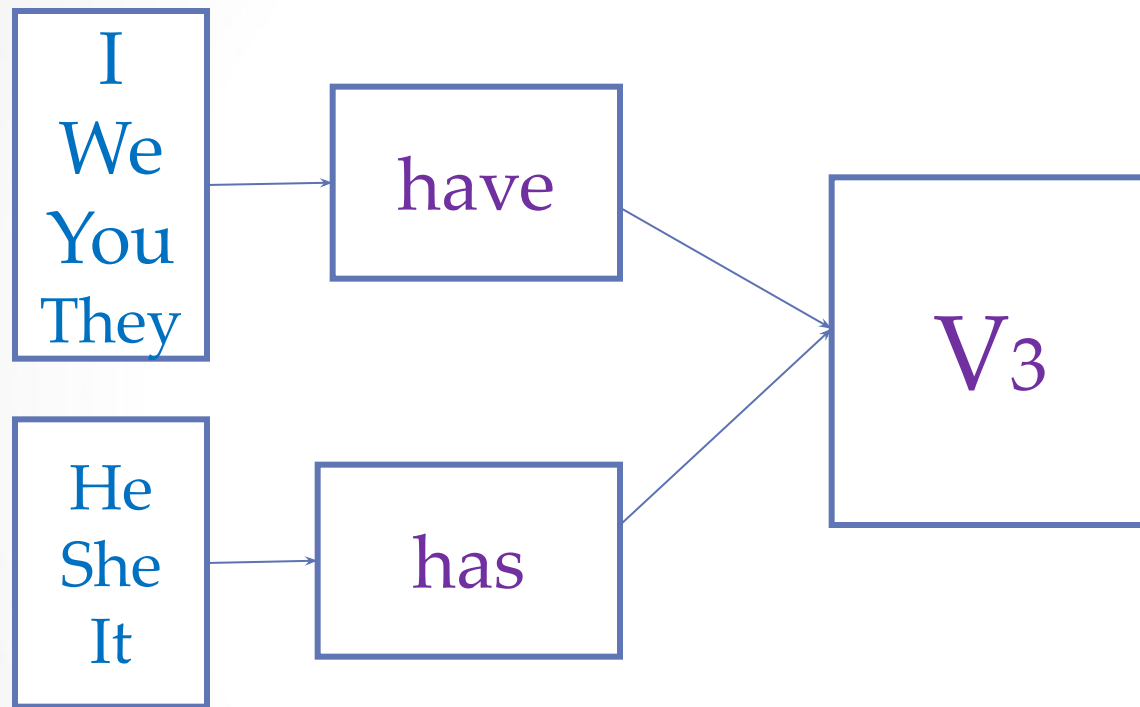

The Present Perfect Tense

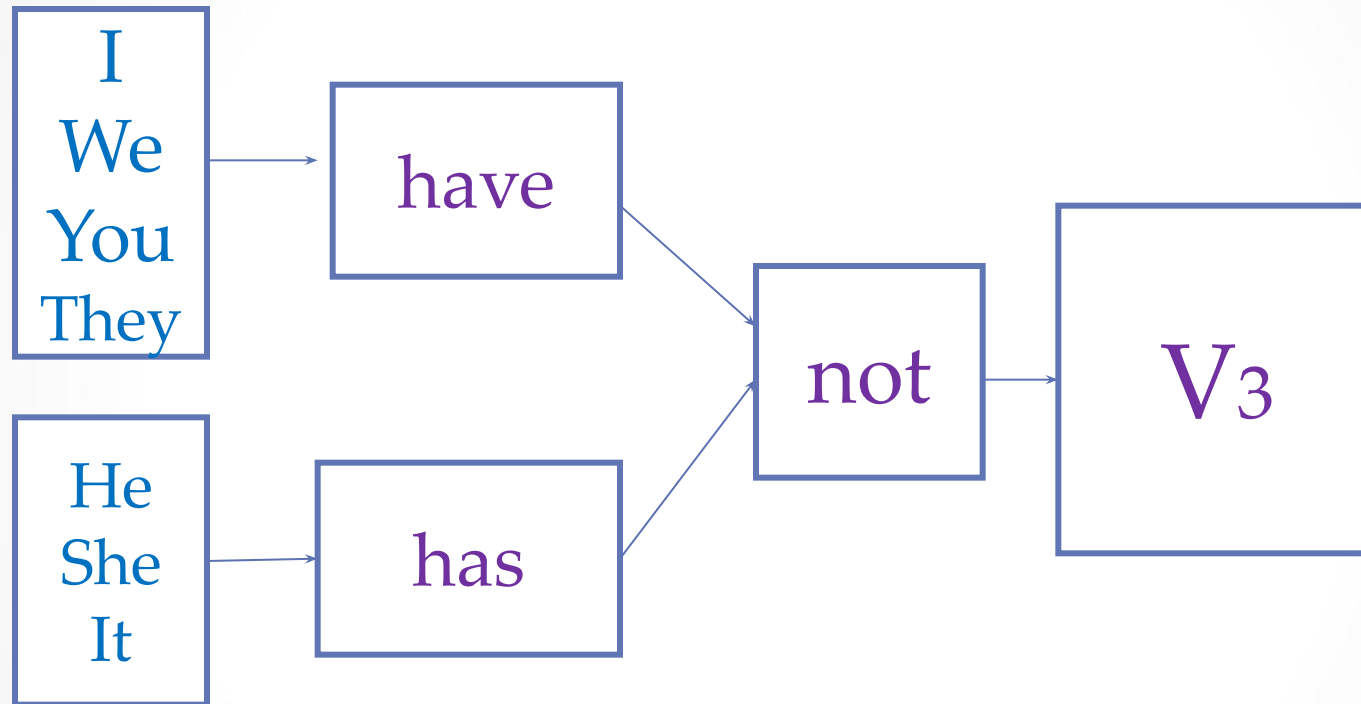
Affirmative sentences

- They have watched the film.
- He has opened the window.

The Present Perfect Tense

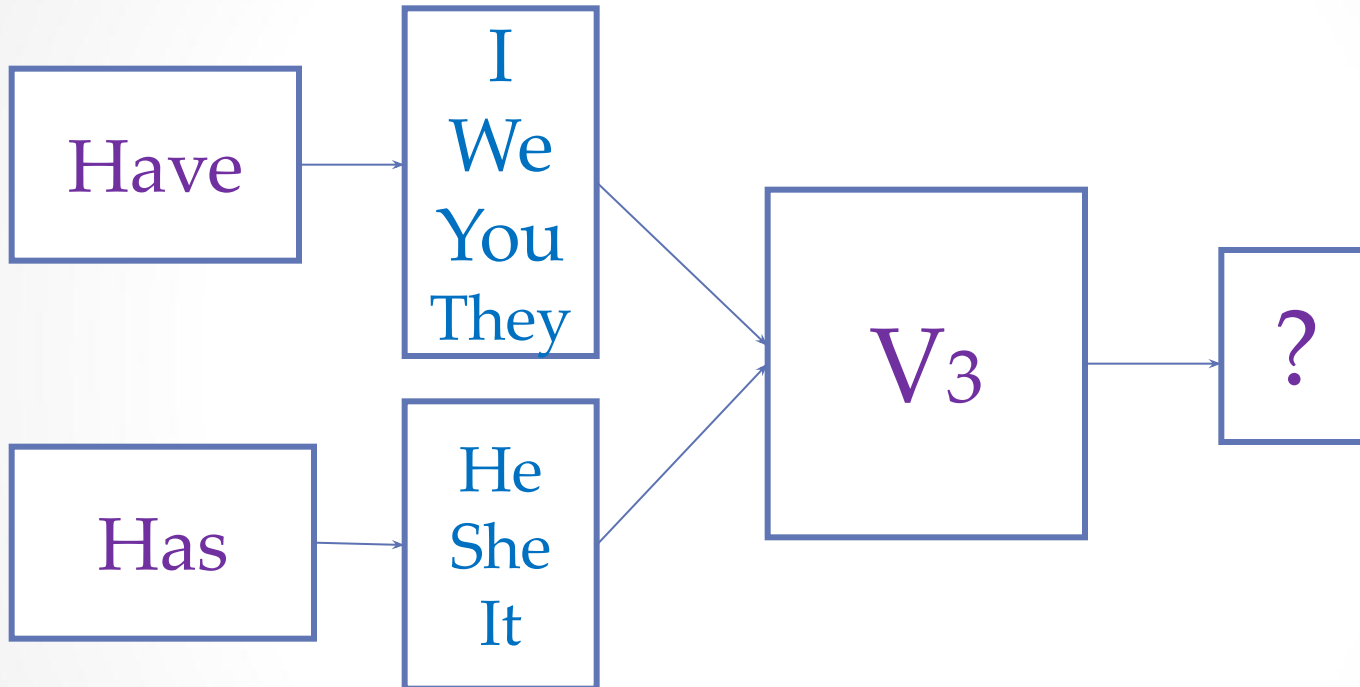
Negative sentences



- I haven't read this book.
- They haven't watched the film.
- He hasn't opened the window.

The Present Perfect Tense

Interrogative sentences



- Have you read this book?
- Have they watched the film?
- Has she opened the window?

Past Simple (важно время)	Present Perfect (важен результат)
I found this disk last week.	I have just found the key.
We didn't go to the seaside last summer.	We haven't gone to the village yet.
Did they see Trafalgar Square when they were in London?	Have they ever seen Trafalgar Square?
When did she live in this city?	How long has she lived here?

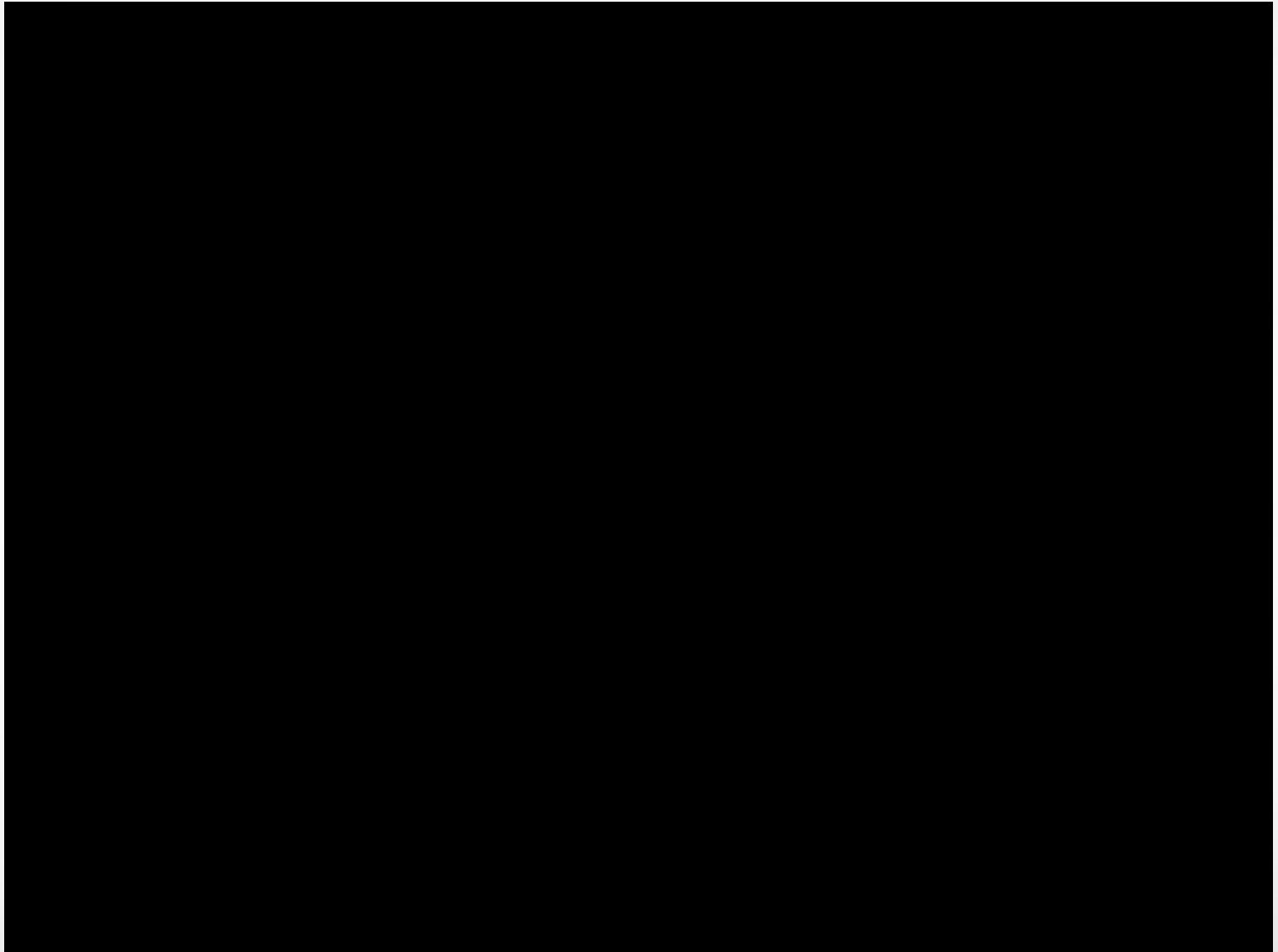
