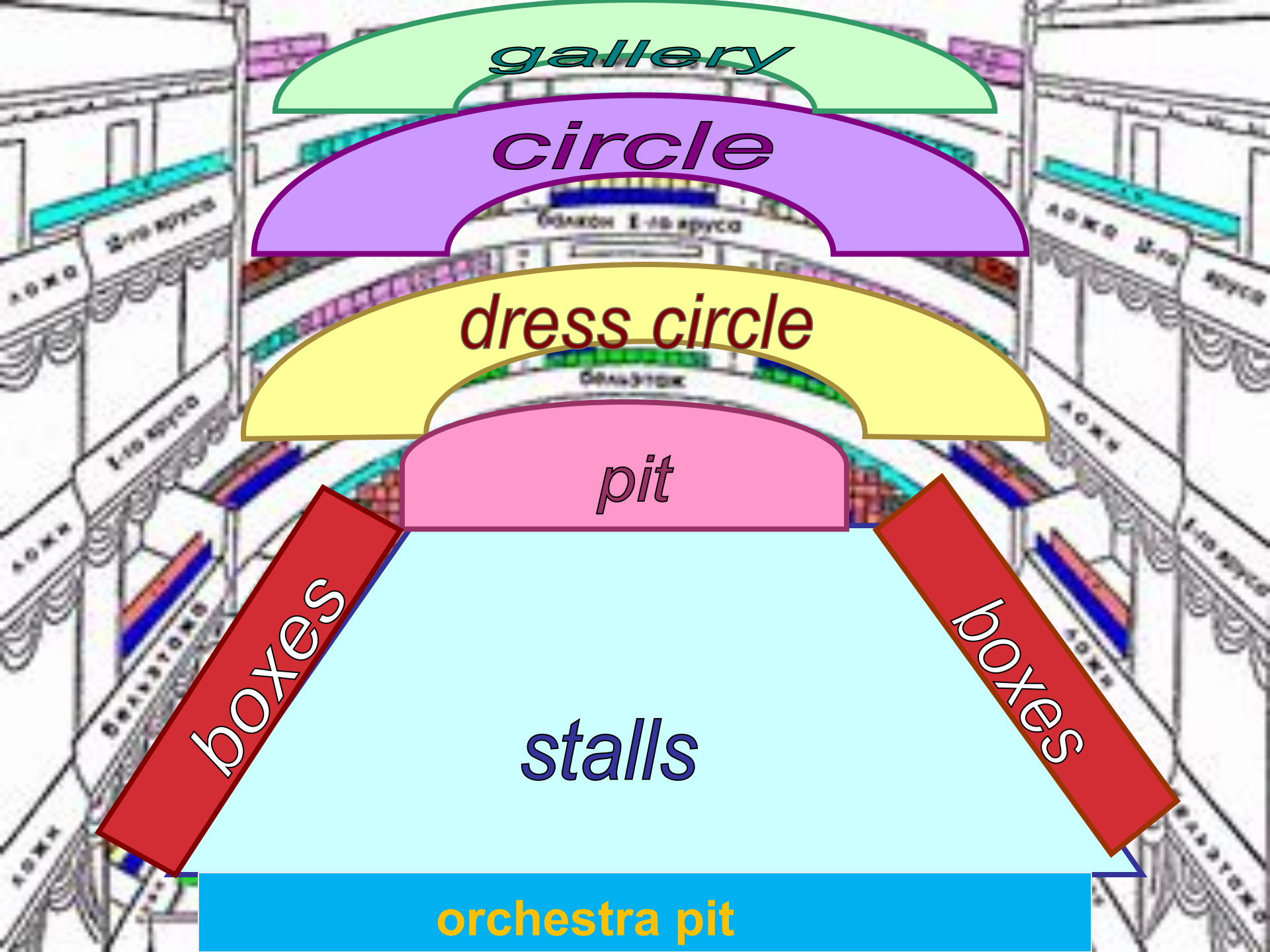

 - The highest floor or a balcony
 - The lowest of the curved rows of seats upstairs
 - The seats at the back of the ground floor
 - The upper floor that has seats, arranged in curved rows
