1. Action happening now

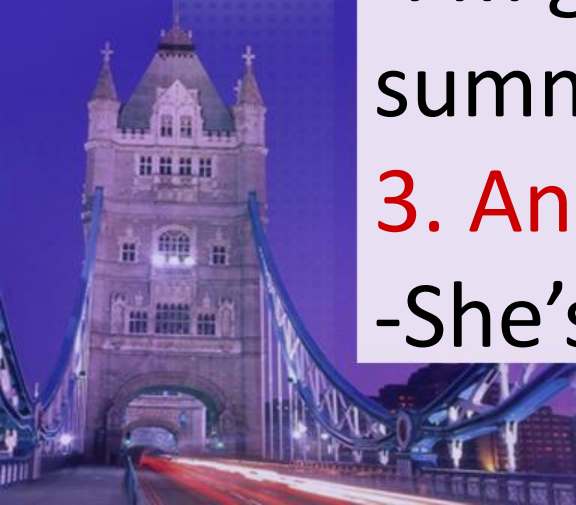
-He's talking to his friend at the moment.

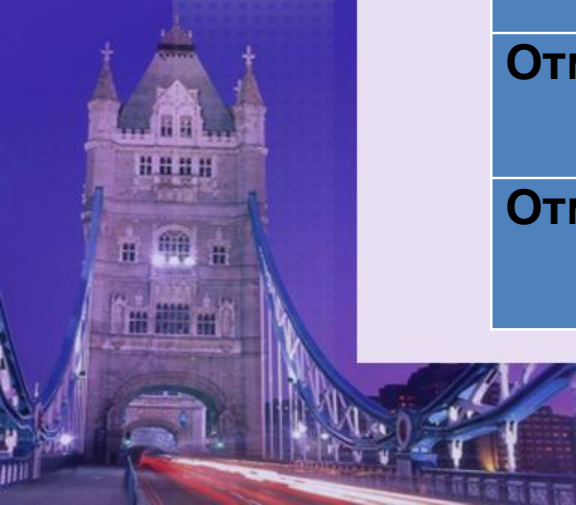

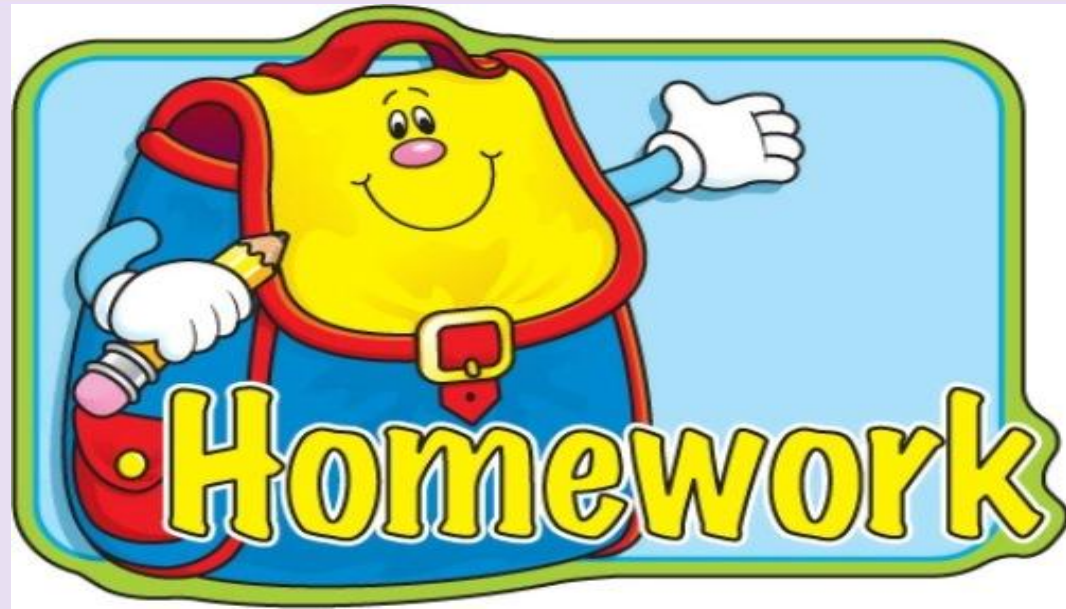
