

state of Veracruz.*



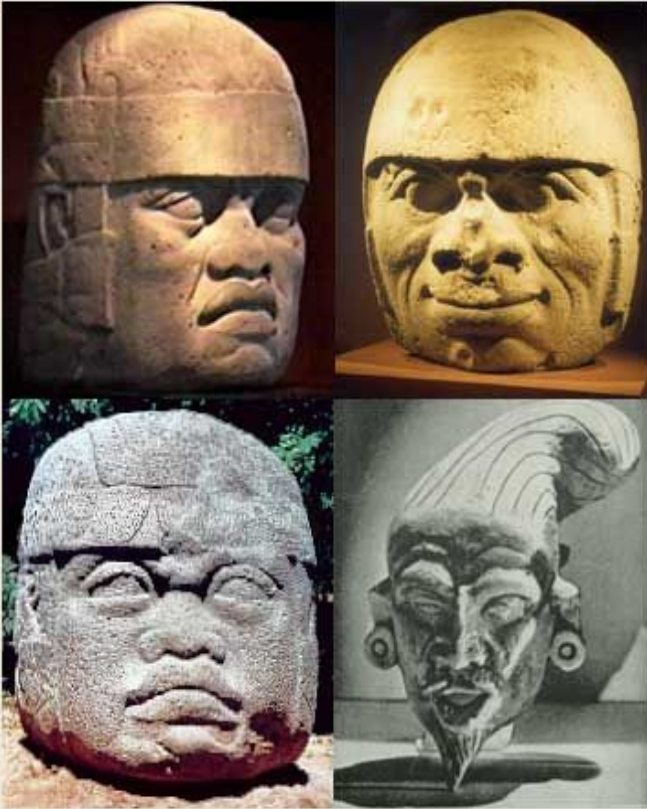

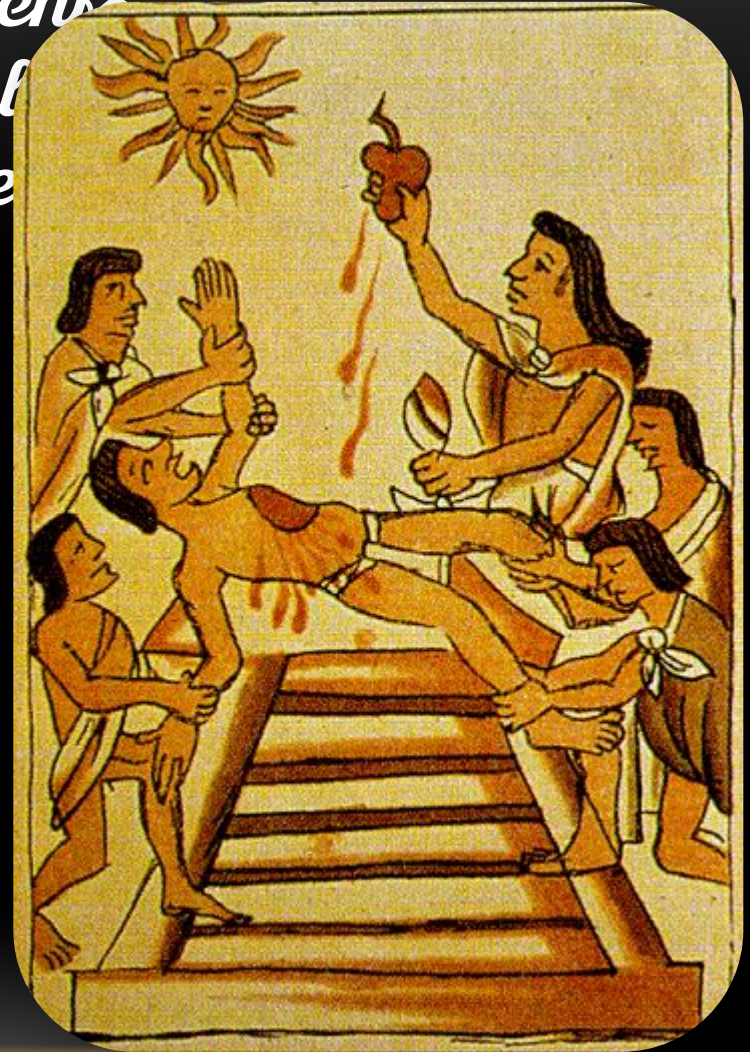
# Olmec Heads

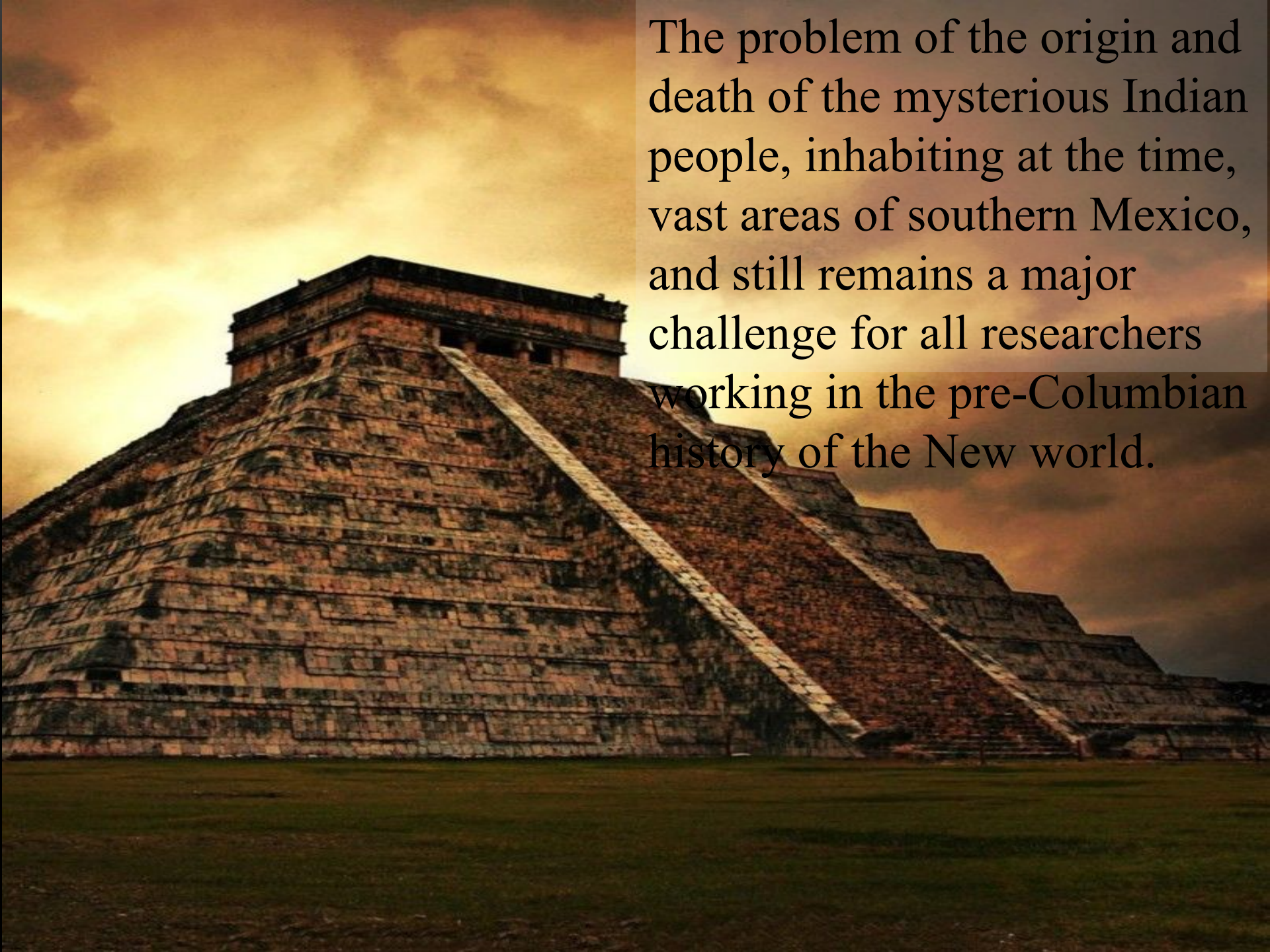
