rellas**

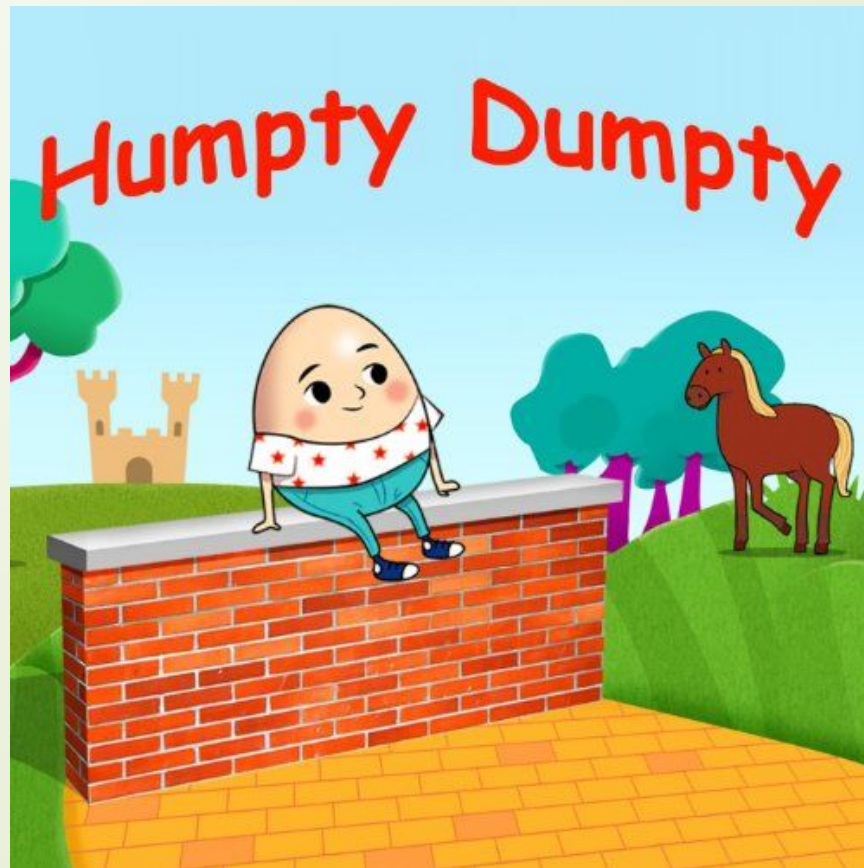


# Two Little Dicky Birds

Come back, Paul.

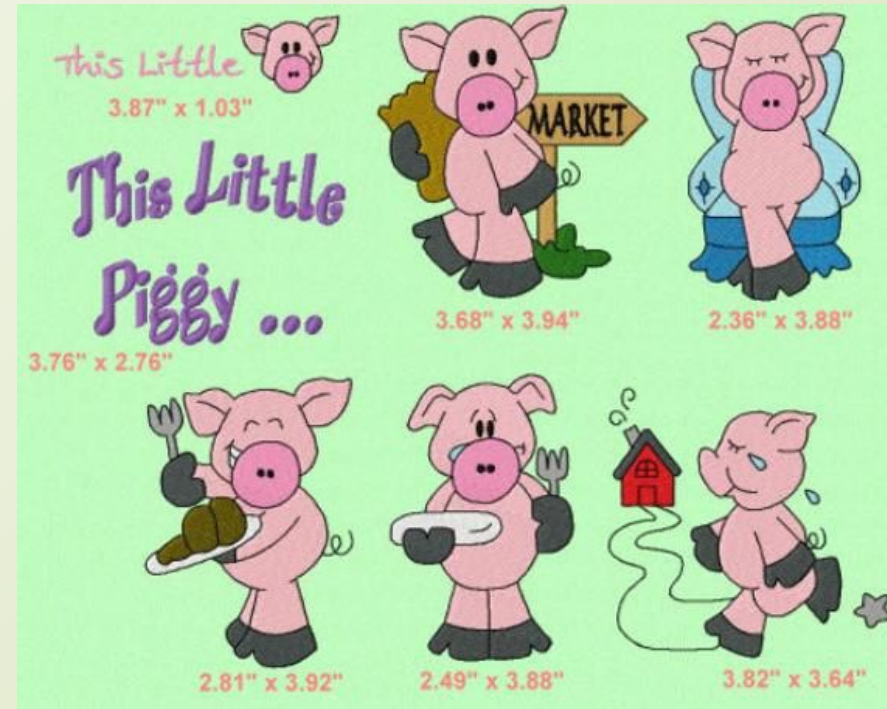


Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall,

If its red or if its green,

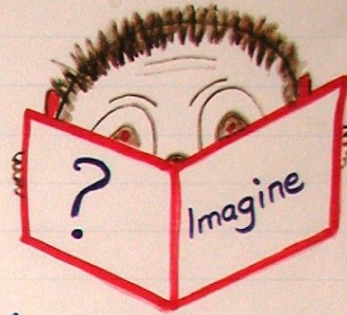
It will taste good if its clean.
