still.**

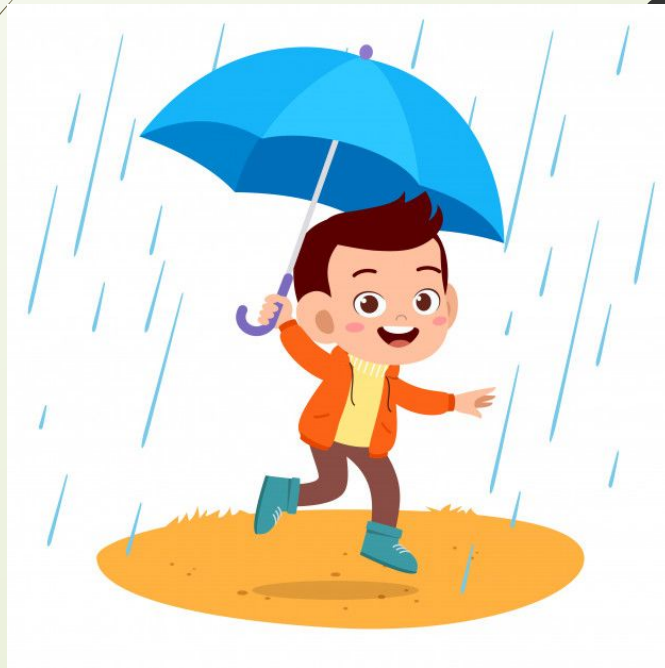
**When the wind

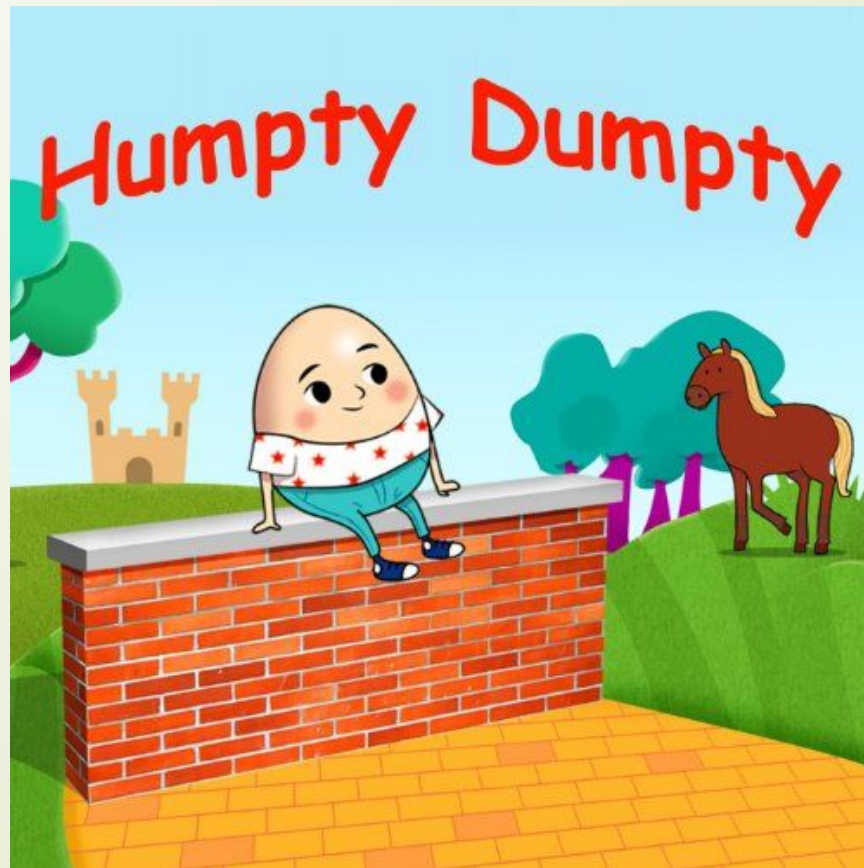


Two Little Dicky Birds

Come back, Paul.

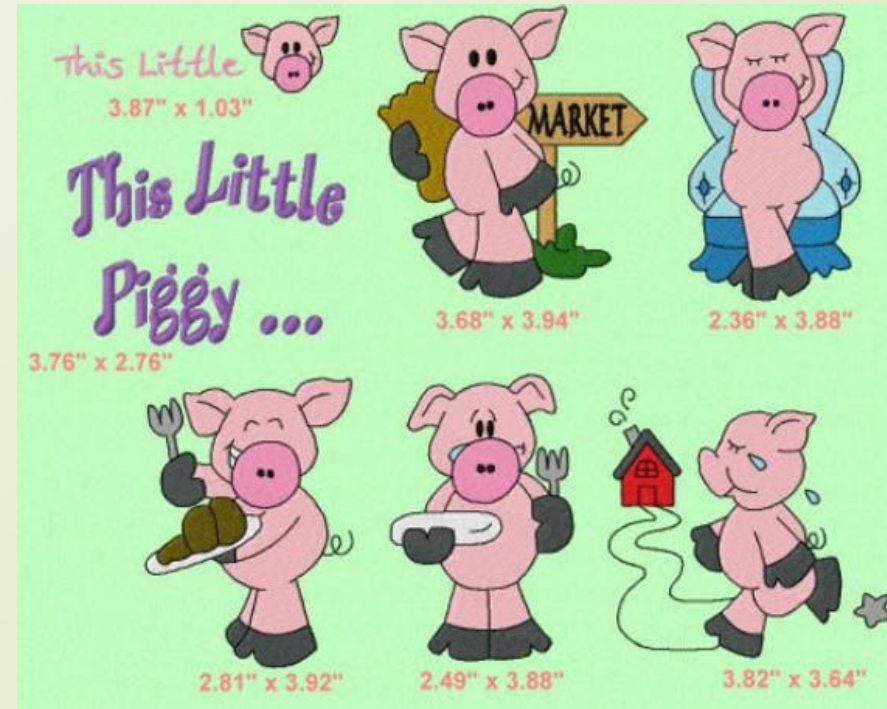


Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall,
