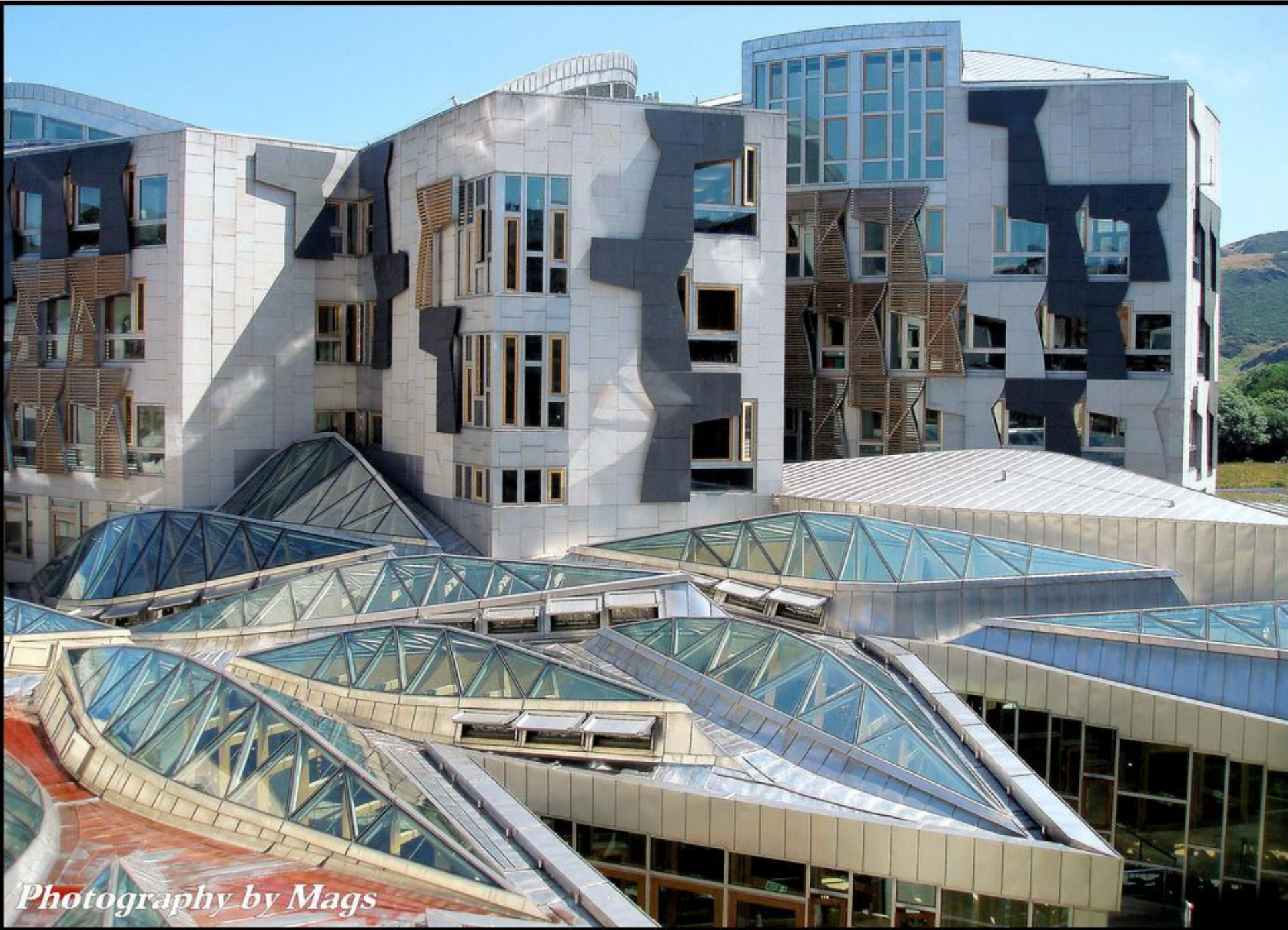

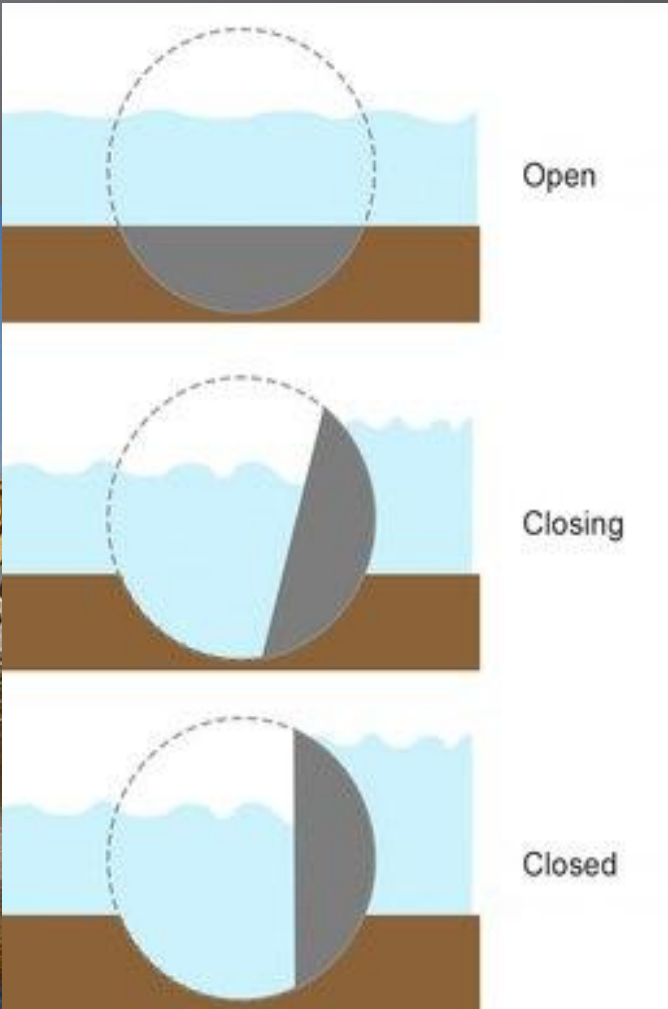
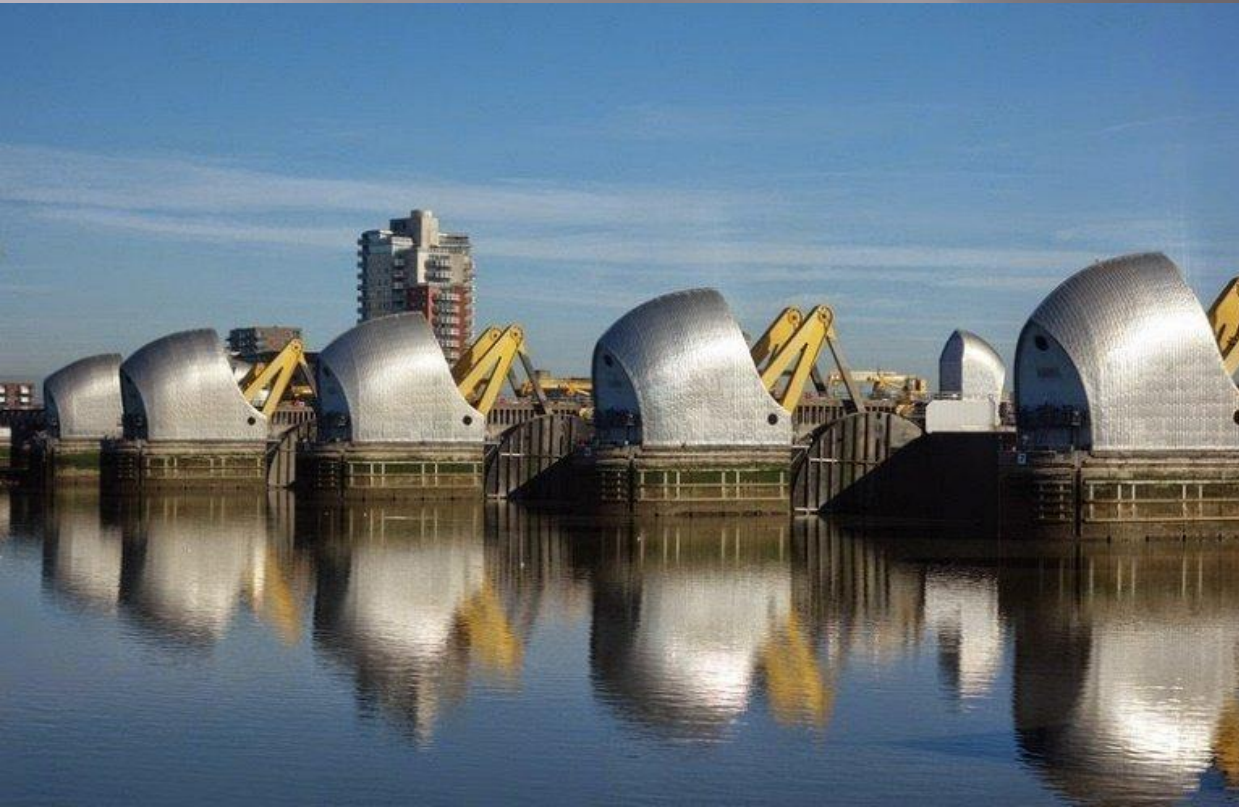






At the time of its construction,

Barrier on the River Thames





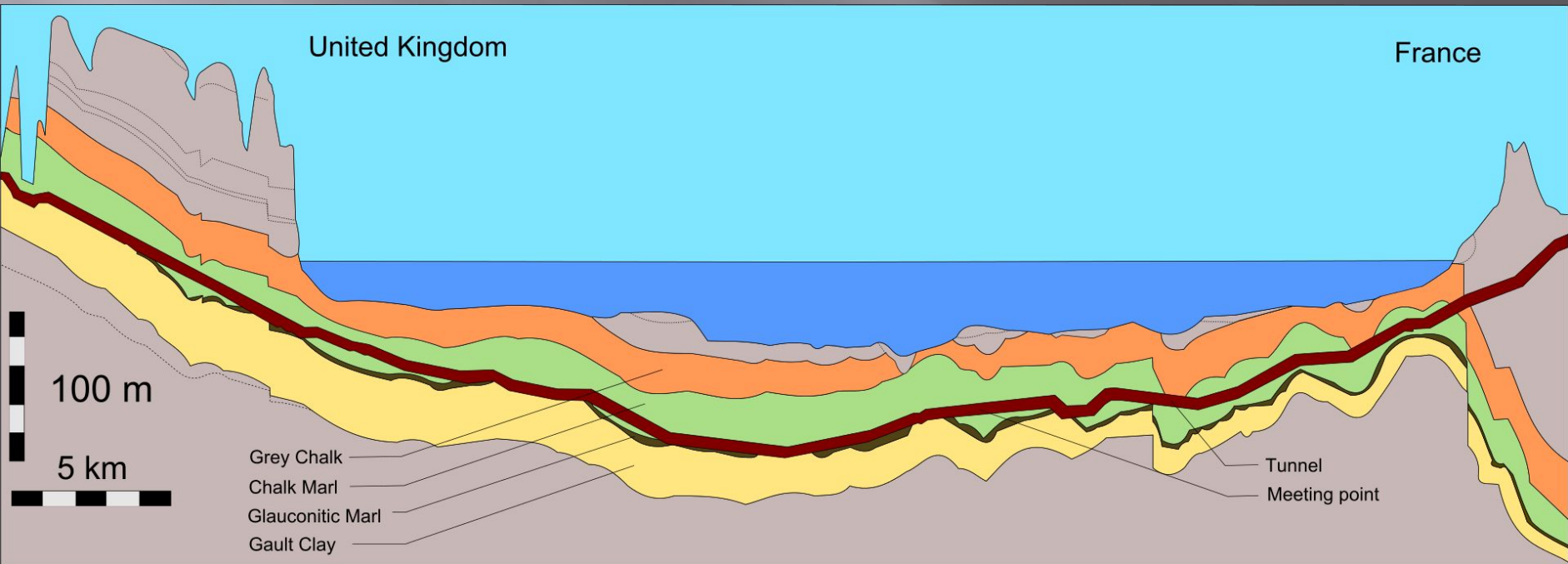




The English Tunnel

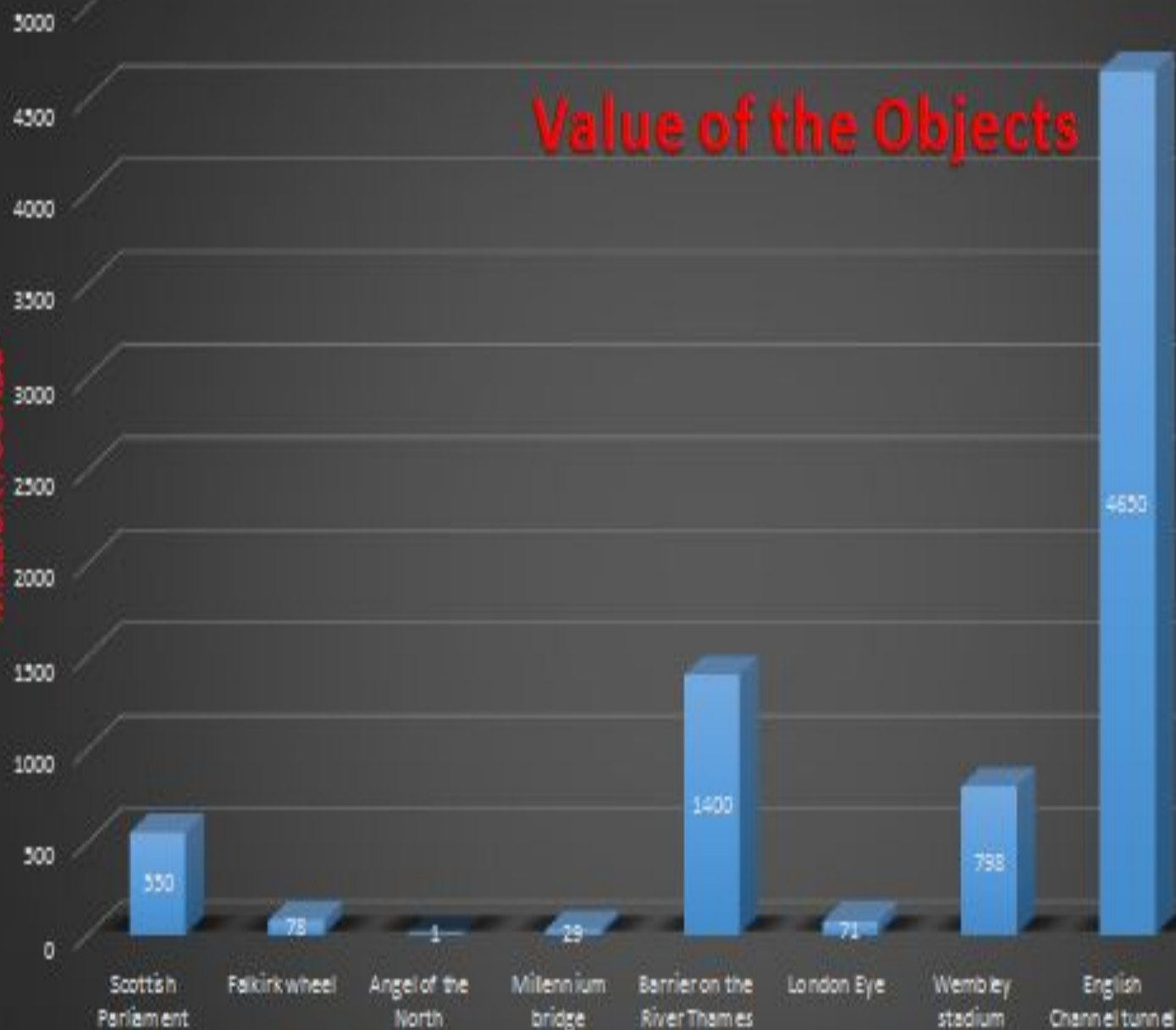

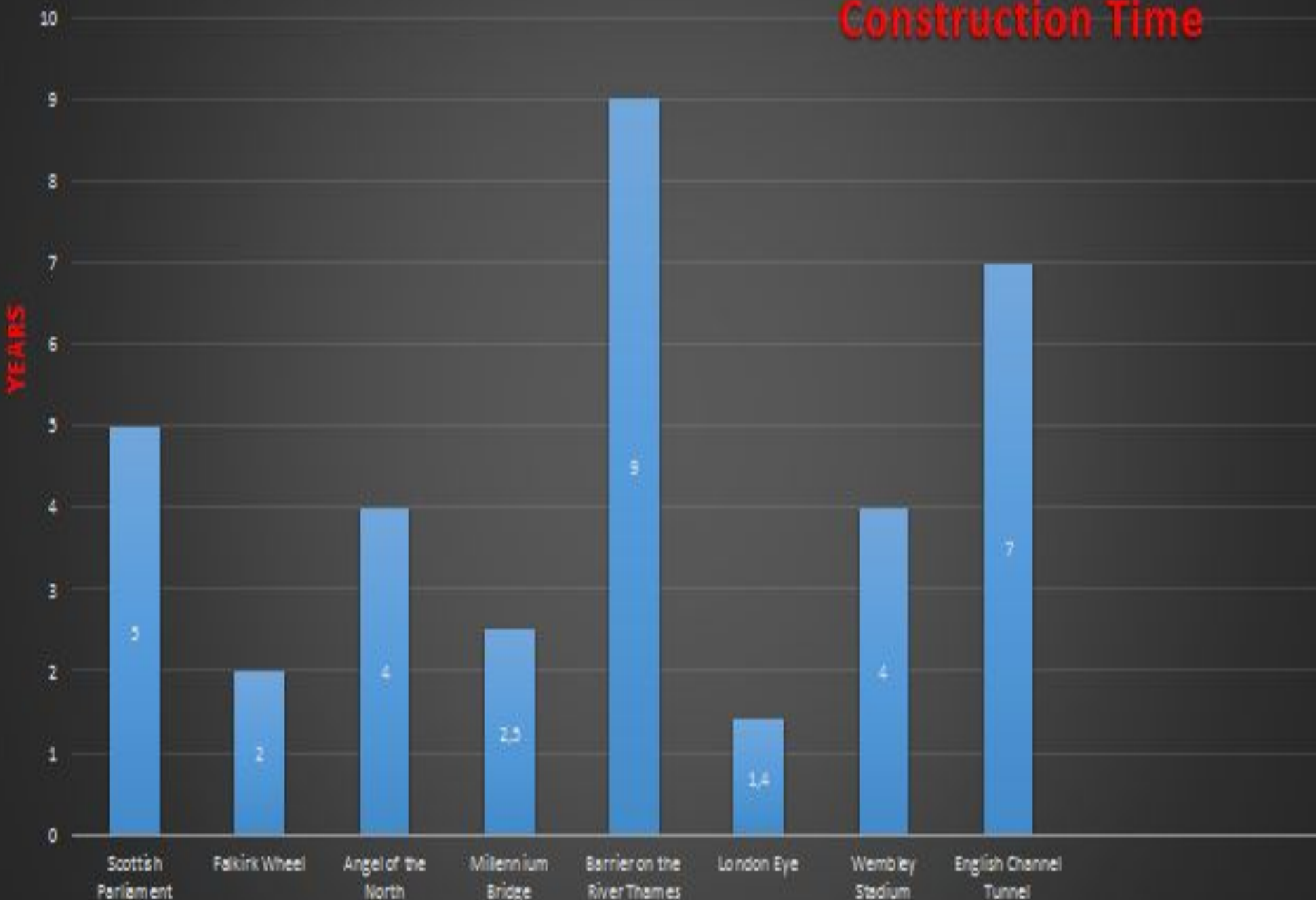
