- There are 3 parts in the English capital: the City, the East End and the West End.

- is also there.



- The best known streets are: Whitehall with important government offices; Downing Street, the London residence of the Prime Minister,



- Fleet Street - where most newspapers once had their offices; Oxford Street – which is famous for its fashionable shops.



- The East End is called “the hands” of London, because working people live in this part of London. Here visitors can see the Port of London, kilometres of docks and great industrial areas, connected with shipping.
