Galapagos sea lion

The Galapagos sea lion can be found on each of the different Islands of the Galapagos archipelago. Sea lion from 150 to 250 cm in length and weigh from 50 to 250 kg, males on average more than females.



Negatively affects the reproduction of sea lions deterioration of environmental conditions, as well as infection from wild dogs.



Sea lions in the Galapagos Islands are under threat of extinction due to the weakening of immunity, which occurs as a result of constant contact with humans, pets

The unusual thin layer of fat in sea lions suggests that their immune system has to deal with external factors, the source of which are people, Pets and Pets. Additional load on the immunity of pinnipeds can lead to a sharp reduction in their numbers in times of famine, scientists conclude.
