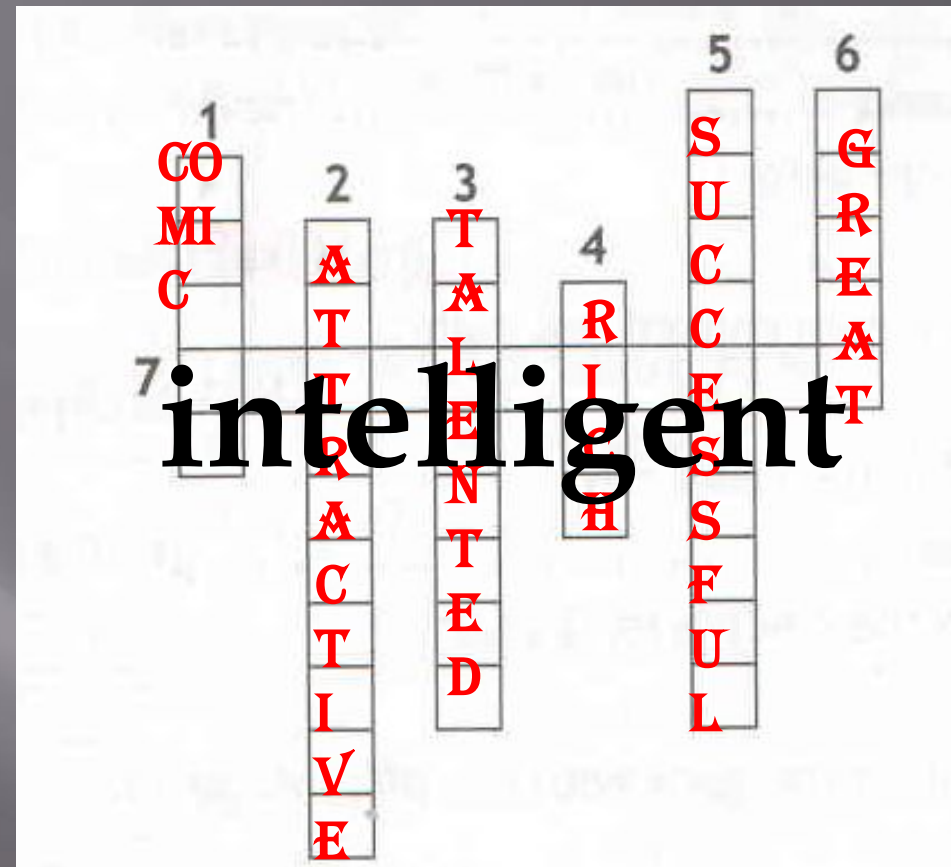

Present Perfect or Past Simple

Past Simple vs Present Perfect

Susan **took** her bike to school *yesterday*.

When we mention **when** an action in the past took place, we use the **past simple**.



Past Simple vs Present Perfect

They **have been** to London.

Several times, this year.

To describe an action that **happened in the past but it's still true in the present**, we use the **present perfect**.
