

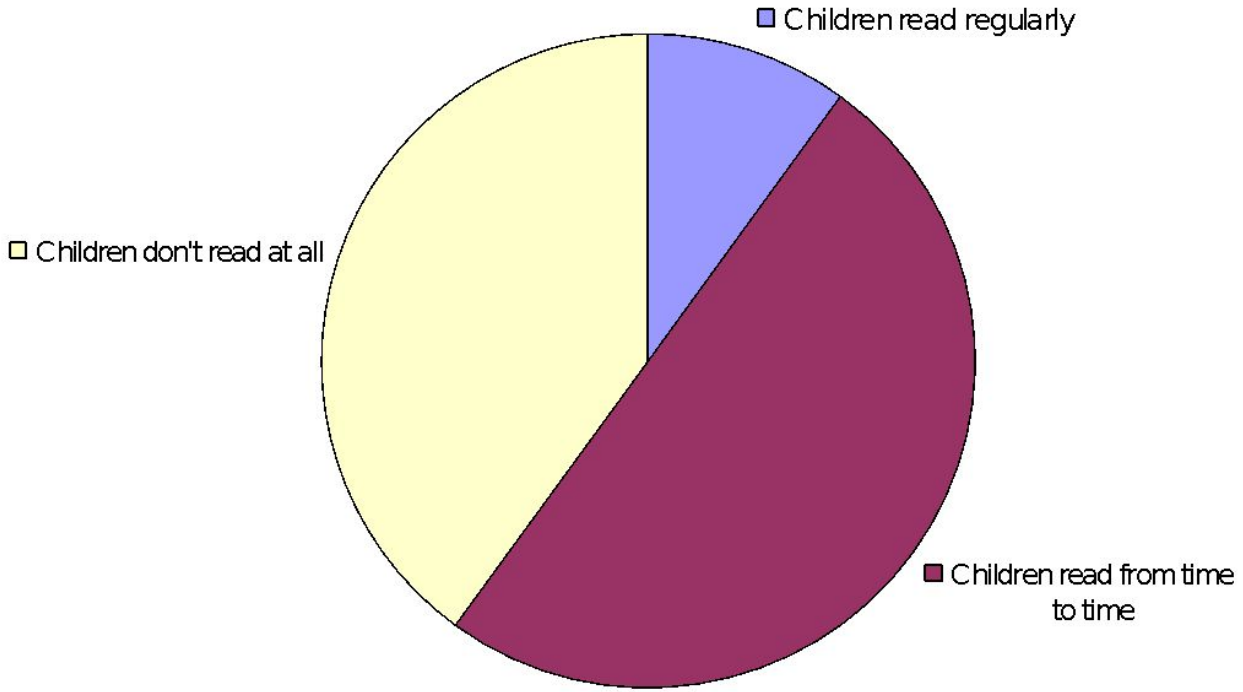
**Do all the good you can,
