Thanksgiving Day (4th Thursday of November)

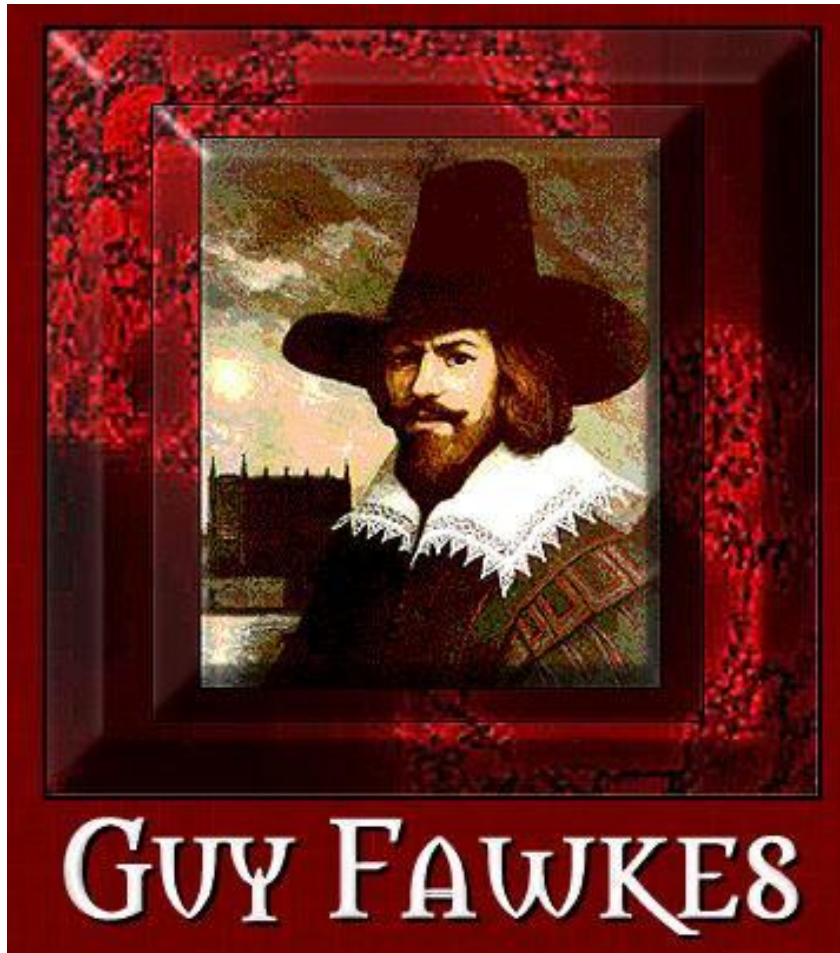

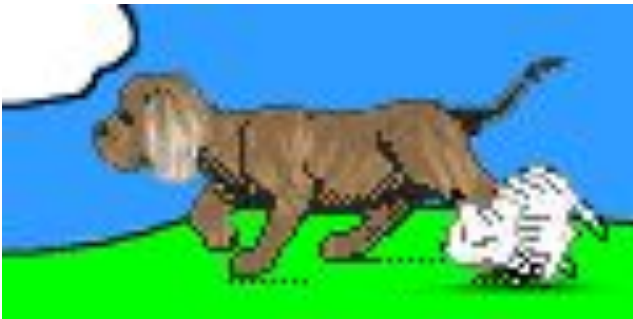
