# Thanksgiving Day (4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of November)

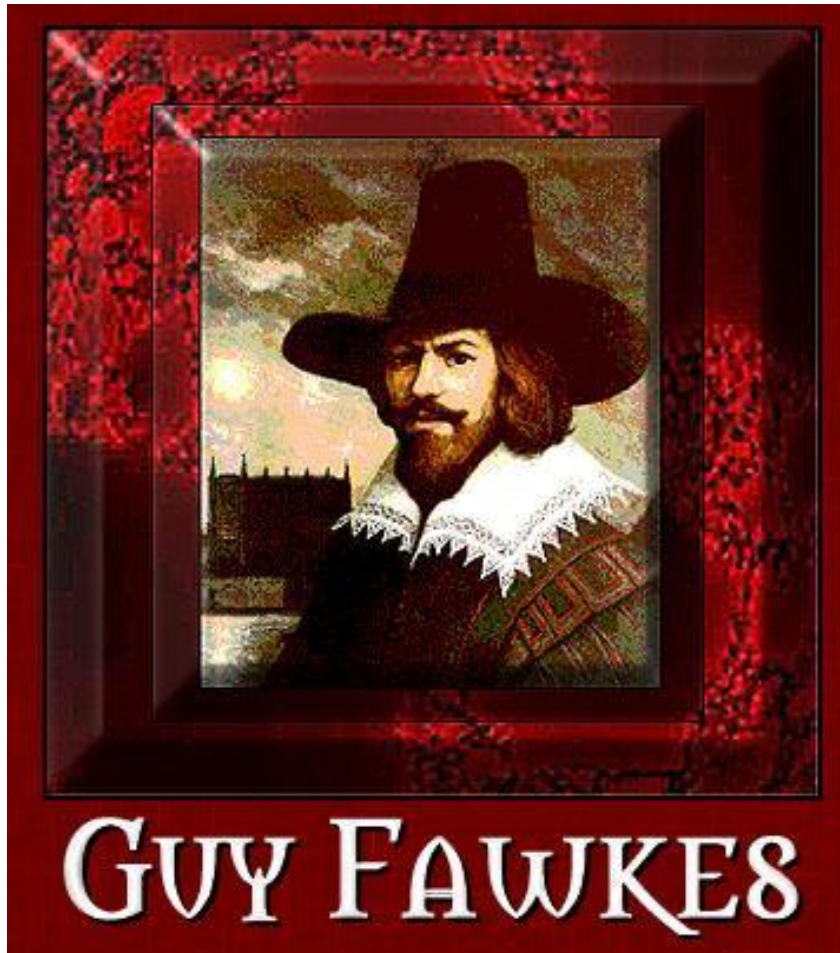

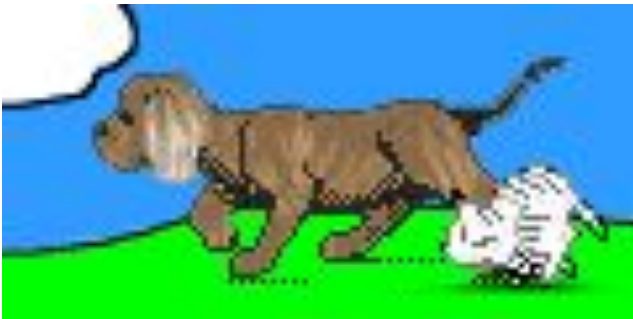
