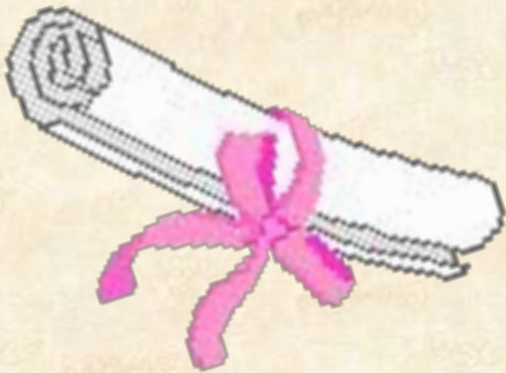


# *The Present Perfect Tense*

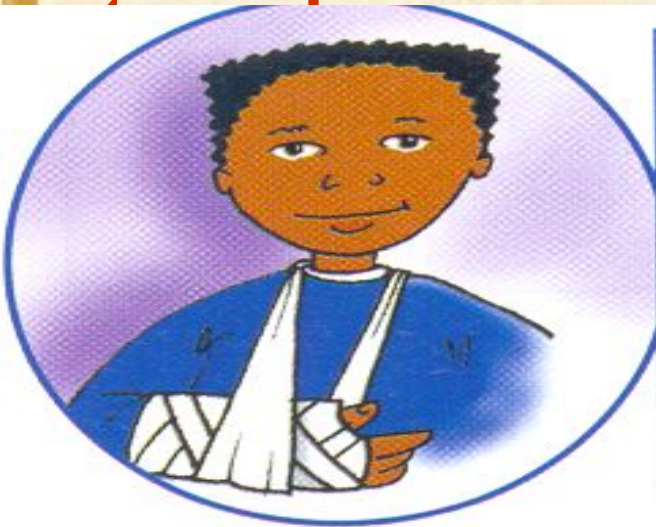

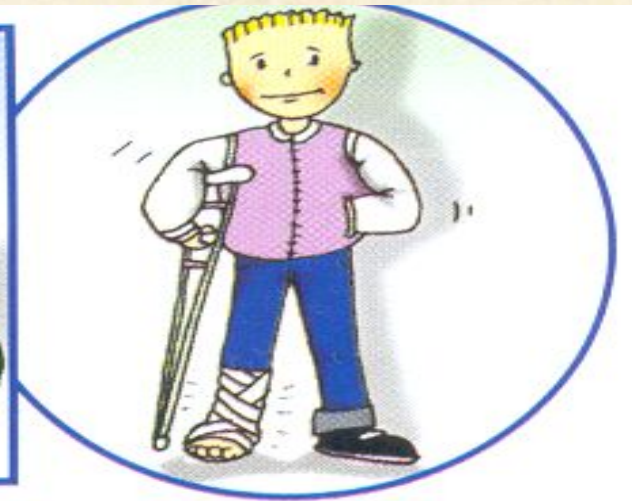
