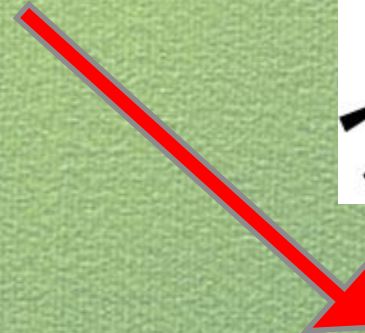
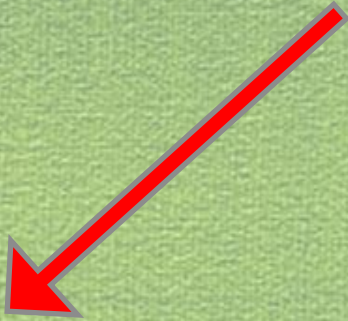

Adaptable

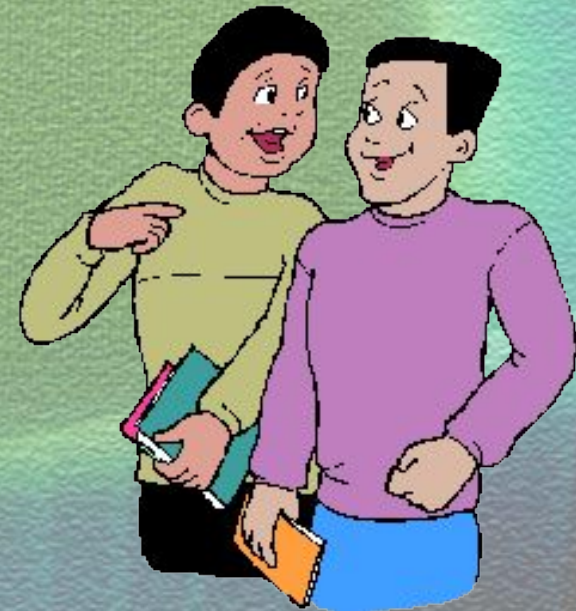


Project Work is highly adaptable Methodology.
