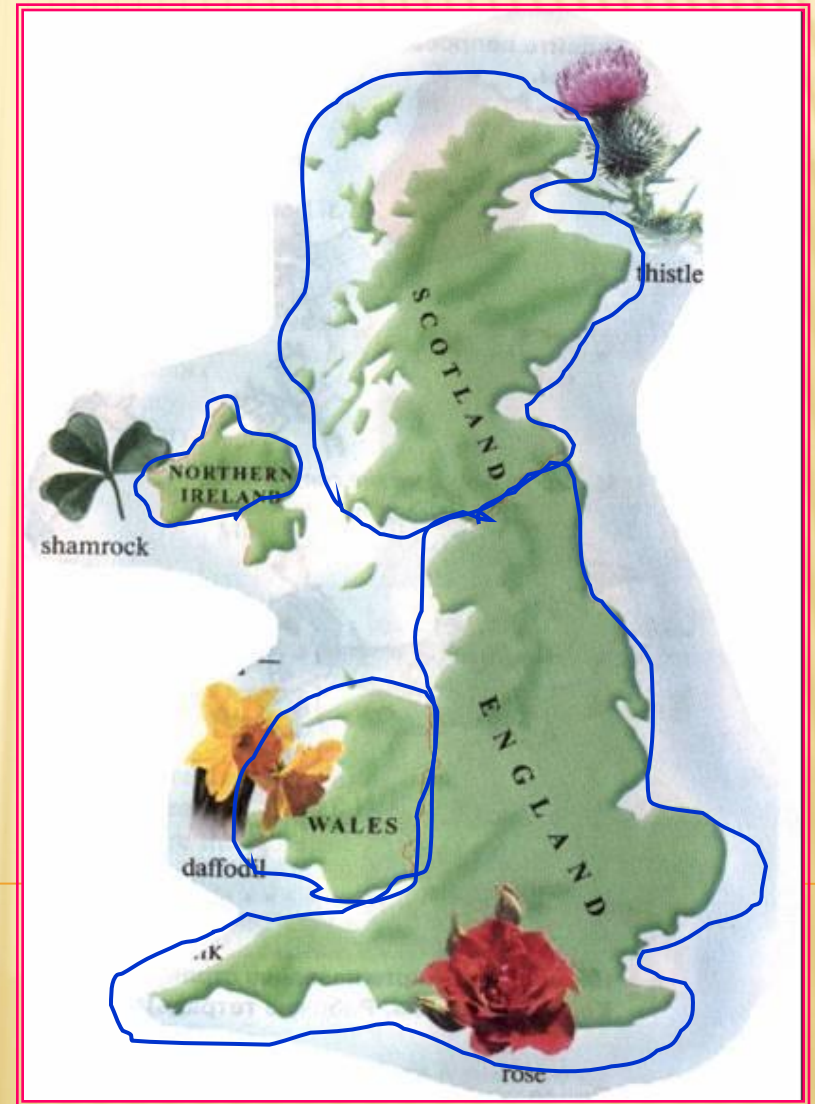
Welcome to London!

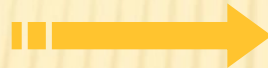
