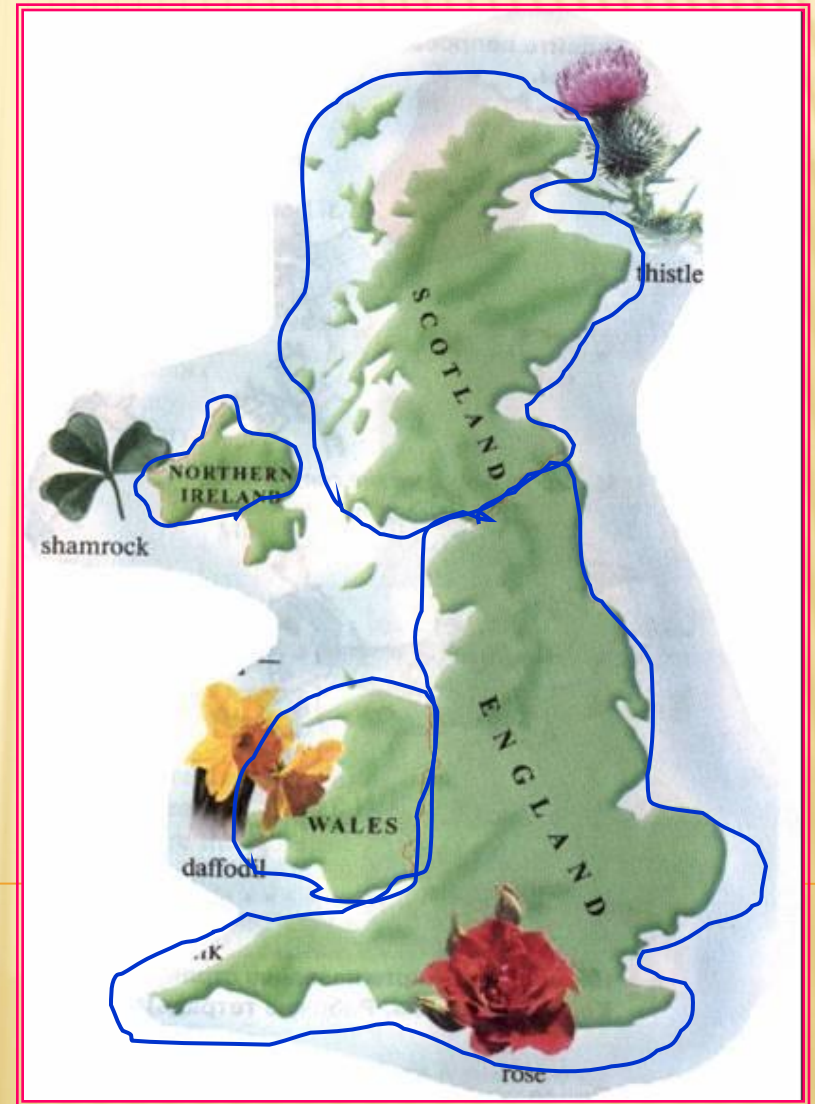
# Welcome to London!

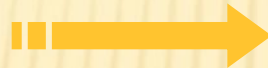
