- Poland is a country in central Europe with a coastline on the Baltic Sea; population - 38,482,900; the official language is Polish
- Warsaw is the capital of Poland. It's a beautiful city with the rich history.



- Warsaw is situated on both sides of the Vistula, almost in the heart of Poland. This is a region rich in folk traditions. The Płock prince Bolesław II of Masovia established Warsaw about 1300. During World War II the Germans then razed Warsaw to the ground. So most of Warsaw lay in ruins. After the war the city was rebuilt.
- Warsaw's palaces, churches and mansions display a richness of color and architectural details. Buildings are representatives of nearly every European architectural style and historical period. The city has wonderful examples of architecture from the gothic, renaissance, baroque and neoclassical periods, all of which are located within easy walking distance of the town centre.

- The greater part of Austria lies in the cool/temperate climate zone in which humid westerly winds predominate. With over half of the country dominated by the Alps, the alpine climate is the predominant one. In the east—in the Pannonian Plain and along the Danube valley—the climate shows continental features with less rain than the alpine areas. Although Austria is cold in the winter ($-10 - 0$ °C), summer temperatures can be relatively warm, with average temperatures in the mid-20s and a highest temperature of 39.7 °C (103.5 °F)

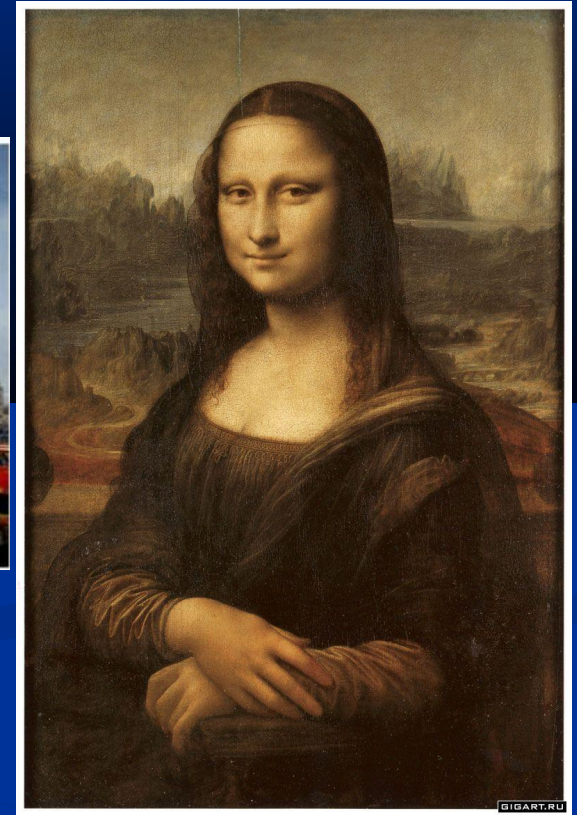

The famous stairs in Vatican City





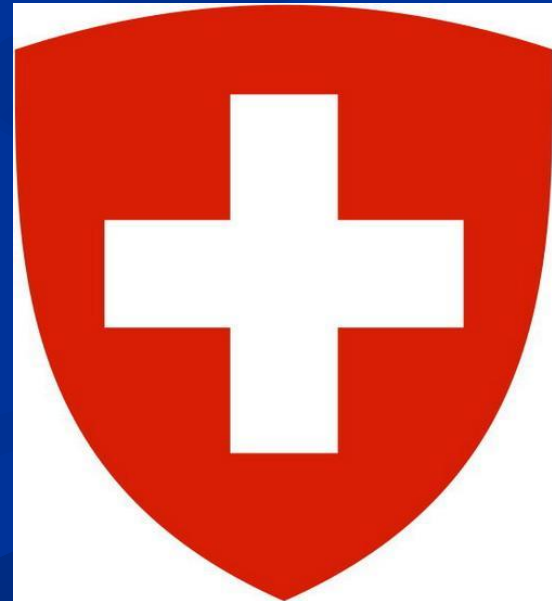
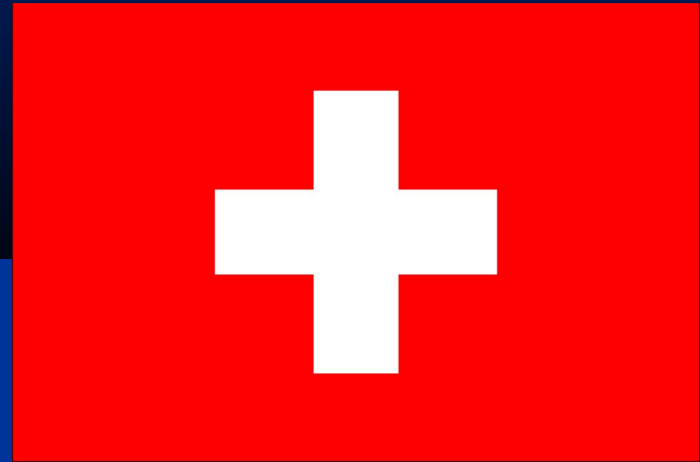

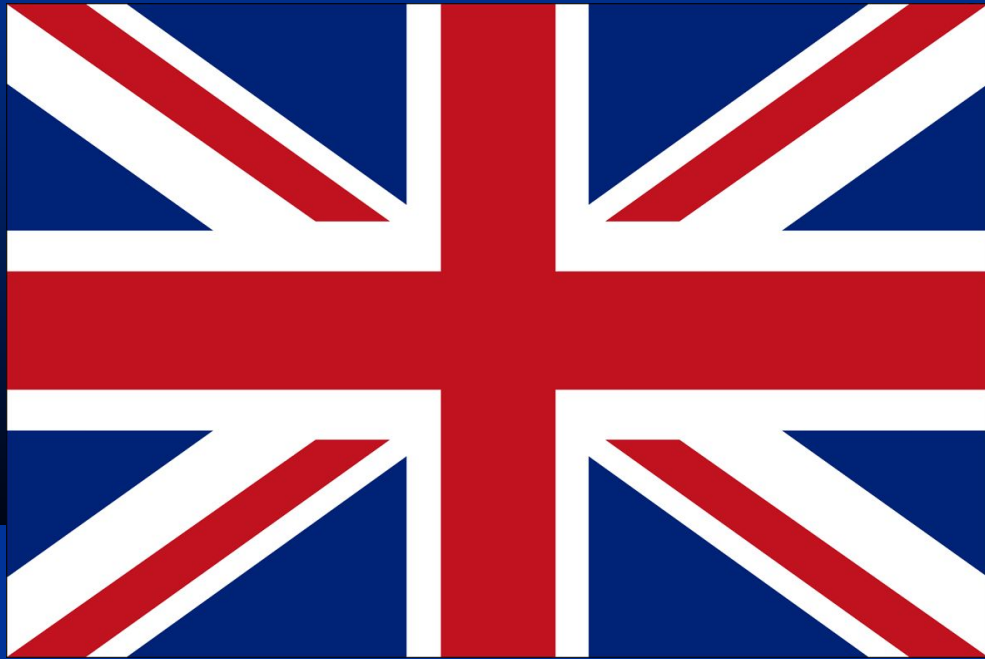
