



Lake Pleshcheevo is highly popular for recreational use today and is a former resort for the Russian tsars. The lake is well known for camping, swimming, and fishing.

The lake is located in the central part of the East European Plain, about 130 km northeast of Moscow, in the basin of the Upper Volga. On the southeast shore is the resort town of








One of Lake Pleshcheyevo's inhabitants is the "freshwater herring" (ryapushka in Russian). The city of Pereslavl's coat of arms has two golden fish on a black ground. This town was known in the Middle Ages for exporting smoked ryapushka, which was the favorite fish at the Tsars' table.





In 1925 author Mikhail Prishvin spent a year at a research station near the lake and wrote up his observations of the landscape in the widely admired Springs of Berendey.

Lake Pleshcheyevo is now a protected area under the Pereslavl Governmental Nature-Historical Natural Park authority.
