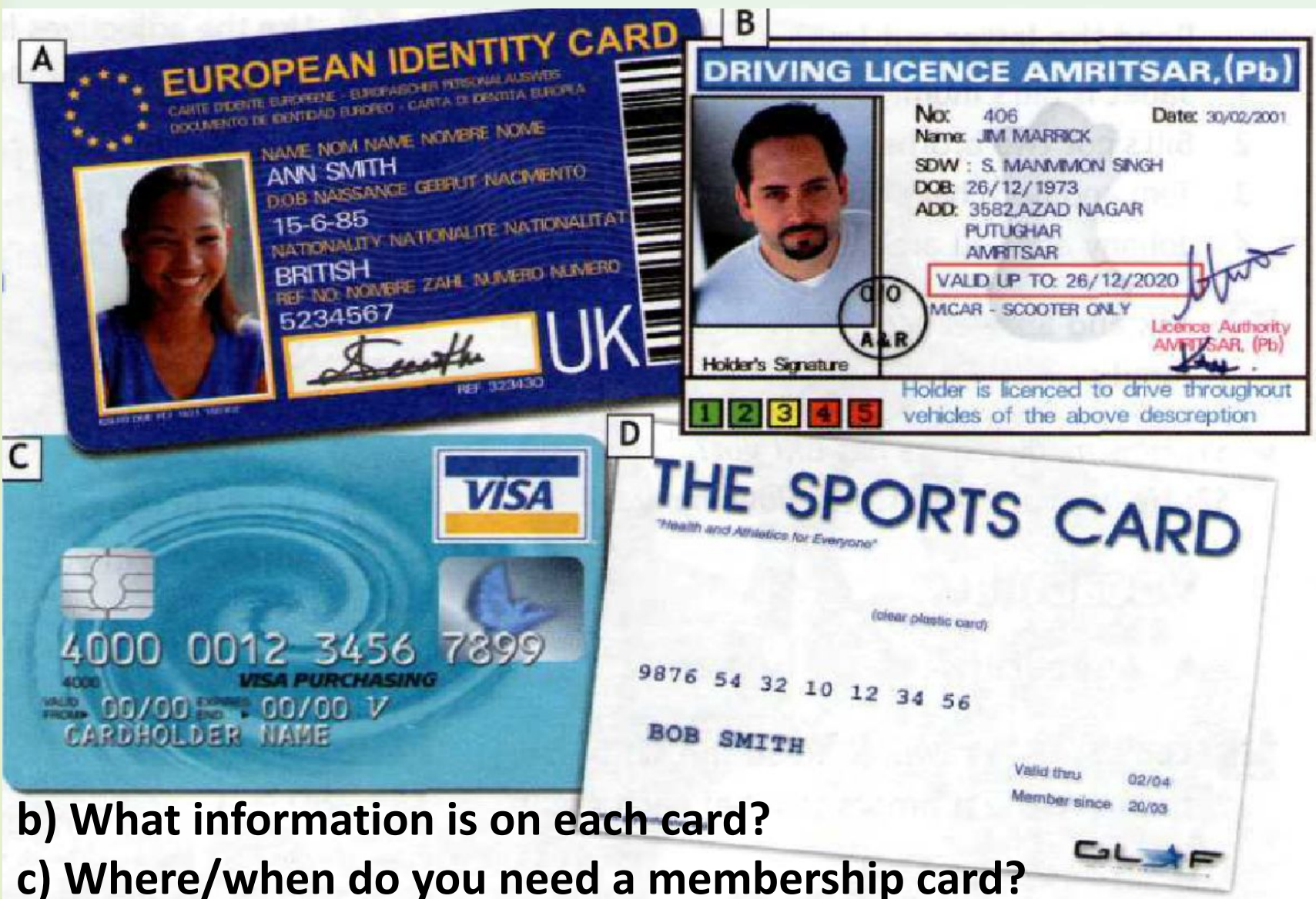

• my → mine

• his → his

• her → hers

• its → its

• our → ours

• your → yours

• their → theirs

e.g. This is **my** book.

It's **mine**. ❌
