
NATURAL DISASTERS.







AN EARTHQUAKE IS A SUDDEN SHAKING OF THE GROUND. A TERRIBLE EARTHQUAKE WAS IN CHINA IN 1556, IT KILLED \$30000 PEOPLE. IN 1923, IN JAPAN, 142000 PEOPLE DIED.

VIOLENT WIND OR STORM, IT
OFTEN BRINGS HEAVY RAINS.


TORNADO.

- A TORNADO IS A VERY VIOLENT WIND IN THE FORM OF A FUNNEL OF AIR THAT SPINS AT GREAT SPEED.
- TORNADOES ARE THE MOST VIOLENT OF ALL STORMS, THEY CAN REACH SPEEDS OF UP TO 320 KILOMETERS AN HOUR.
