hot- hotter- the hottest

big - bigger - the biggest

fat – fatter- the fattest







Если односложное или двусложное прилагательное оканчивается на букву у, то при образовании сравнительной и превосходной степеней буква у заменяется буквой і, а затем прибавляется соответствующий суффикс.

Remember

sunny – sunn<u>ier</u> – the sunn<u>iest</u> happy – happ<u>ier</u> – the happ<u>iest</u> hungry – hungr<u>ier</u> – the hungr<u>iest</u> dirty – dirt<u>ier</u> – the dirt<u>iest</u>

large - larger - the largest white - whiter - the whitest nice - nicer -the nicest wide - wider - the widest late - later - the latest




