

# “Synquane”

- The **synquane** is a special form of the poem, which consists of 5 lines:
    1. one word title, a noun that tells what your poem is about
    2. two adjectives that describe what you're writing about
    3. three- ing participles that describe what your poem is about
    4. a phrase that tells more about what you're writing about
    5. a synonym for your title, another noun that tells what your poem is about.
