- Make recommendations to the groups’ web quests (Strategy “Praising sandwich”)

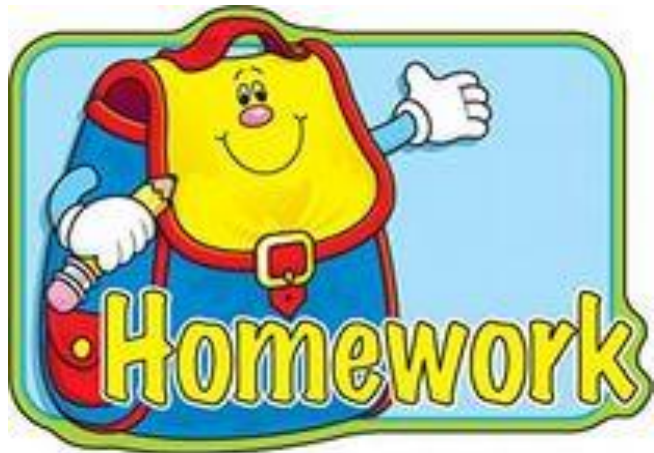
