## The museum of the History of Mogilev

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I strongly recommend you to visit the museum of the history of Mogilev. This museum is one of the most interesting museums in Mogilev. It was opened in 1990. Later it moved to the building of the City Hall which was rebuilt a new on the site of the 17<sup>th</sup> century monument of architecture.

The museum is a home to a huge collection of ancient Slavic artifacts (amulets and national Slavic women's and men's jewelry), the collections of printed books and handwritten scrolls, the collections of icons, old prints, paintings and photographs.









There are some rare and unique exhibits, which will help you to discover how people lived many years ago. The museum also hosts a large number of exhibitions of paintings and sculptures by Belarusian and foreign painters and sculptors.
