Nice to meet you!





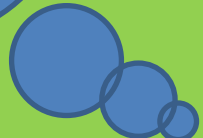
I live in Armavir.

“Let’s talk culture”

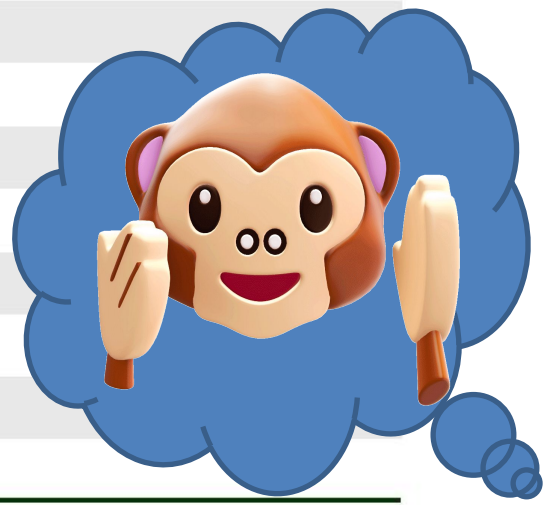
I asked for help our social pedagogue. Her name is Oksana Glebova. And this is the information about our students she gave me.

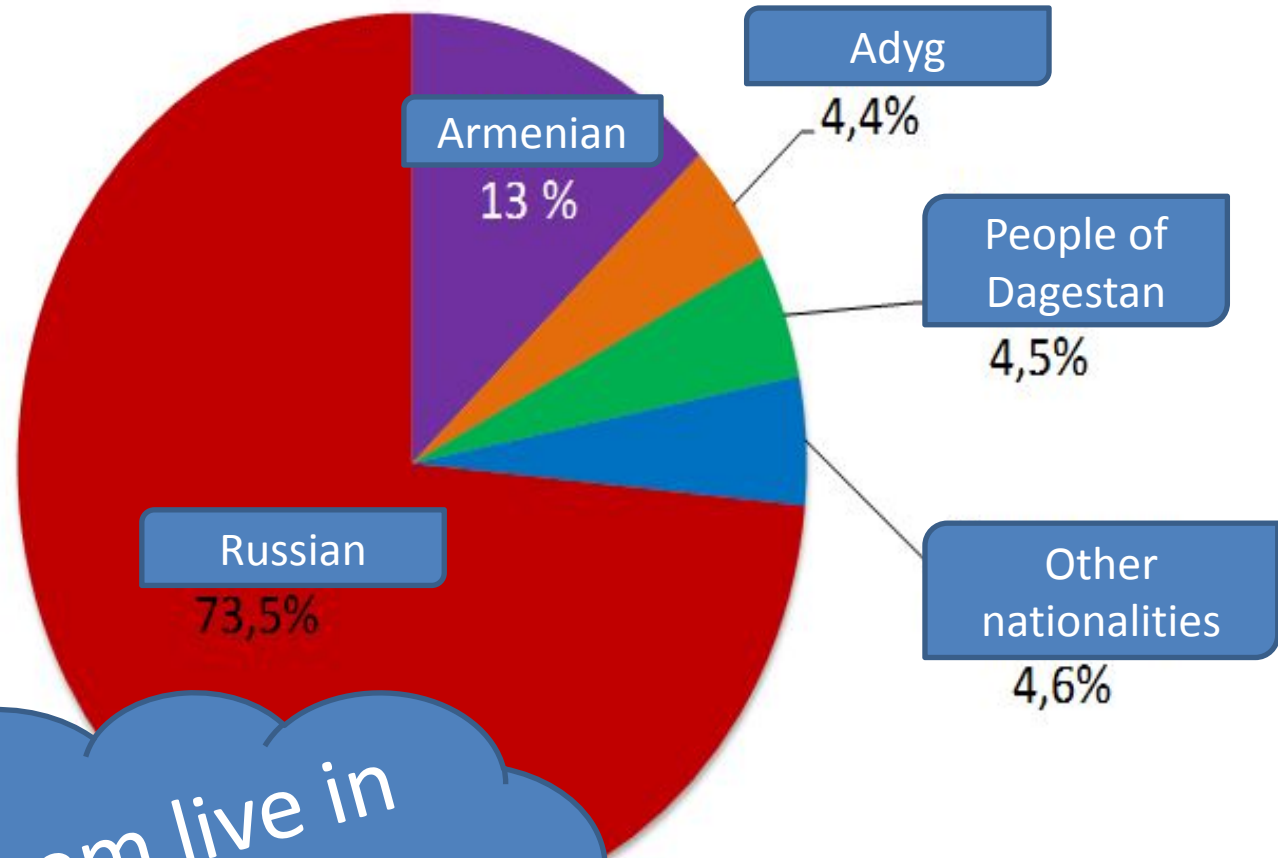

6)

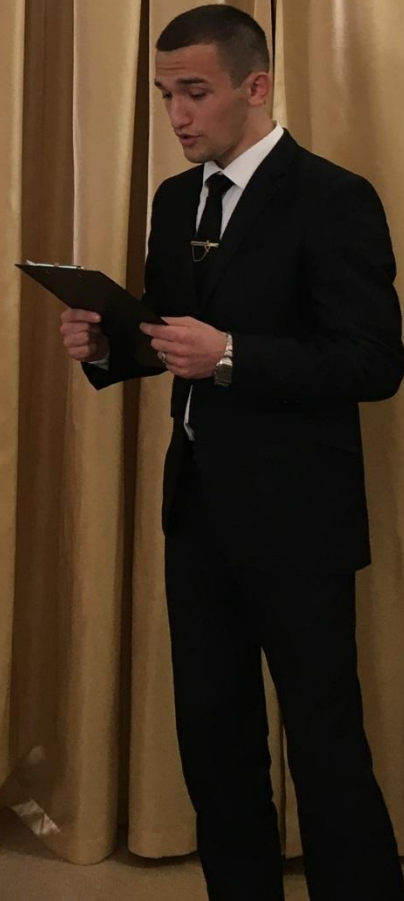
- Art-corner "Romance"
