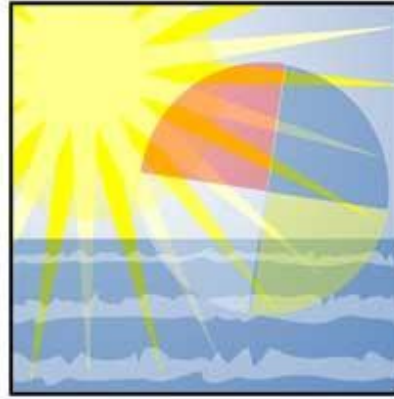
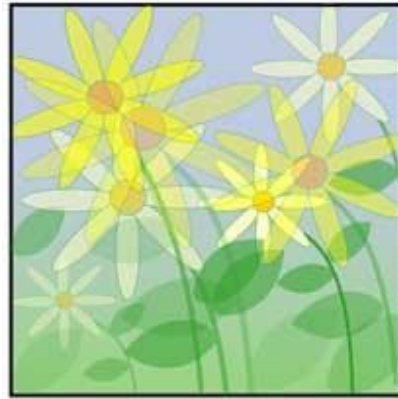

LET'S TALK ABOUT THE RULES

PRESENT SIMPLE



We use Present Simple to describe the action which takes place regularly, every day, usually.

She always wears boots in winter.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS



We use Present Continuous to describe the actions which takes place right now.

She is wearing boots now.

PRESENT SIMPLE OR PRESENT CONTINUOUS

1. He is going to school **now**. (to go)
2. She **always** wears a raincoat in autumn. (to wear)
3. Angela is eating dinner **now**. (to eat)
4. Max is doing his homework **now**. (to do)
5. Oliver goes jogging **every morning**. (to go jogging)
