5th November

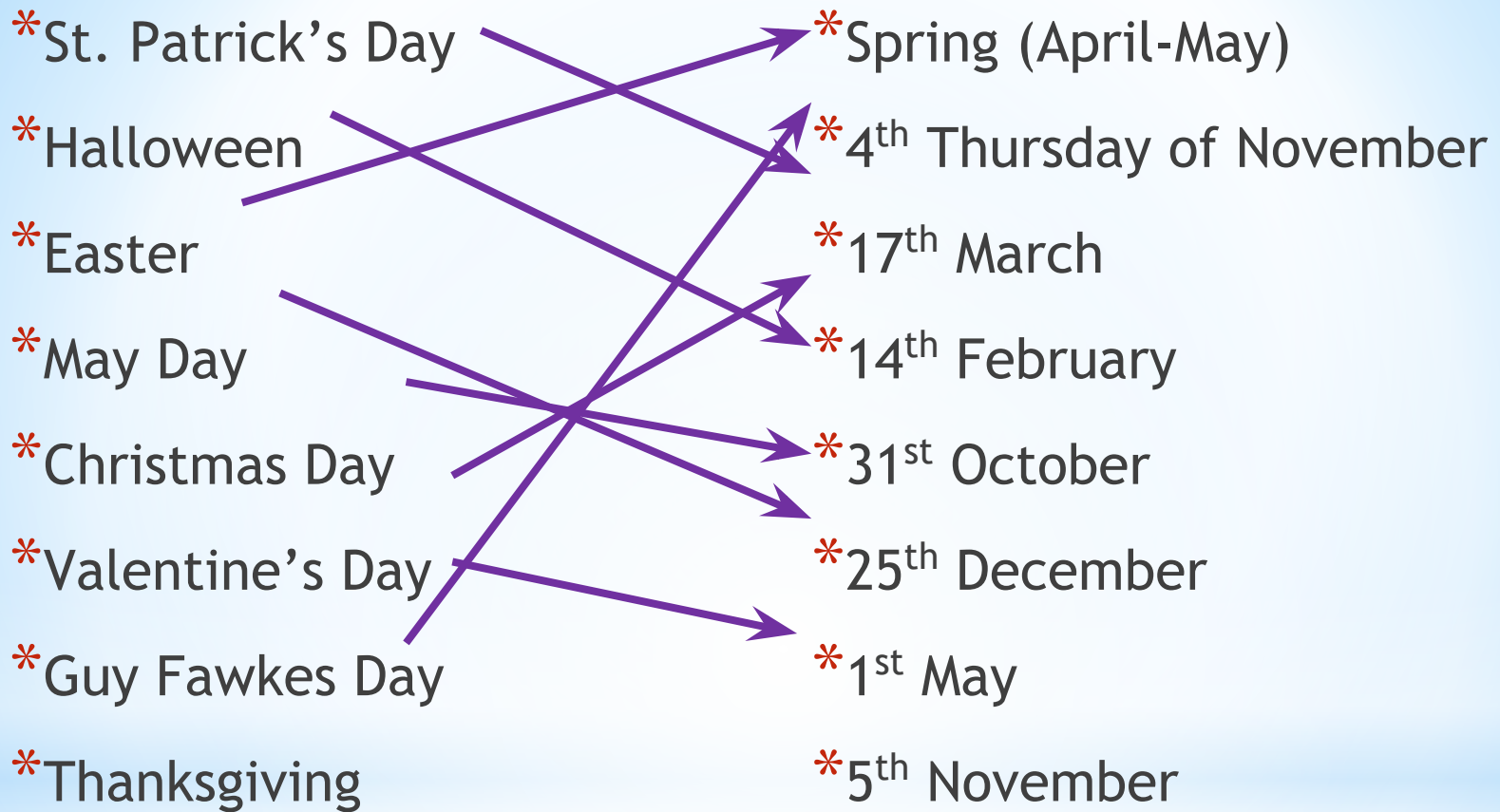
* People like to bring together their relatives, giving thanks for all the good they had in this year.
