Why do spirits hate the living and try to scare them away?


The living always want to clean up their homes, while ghosts prefer dust, spiders and darkness.

Visitors have seen Queen Anna Boleyn, for example, the second wife of King Henry VIII.


The ghost of his fifth wife, Catherine Howard, runs through the rooms of Hampton Court.
