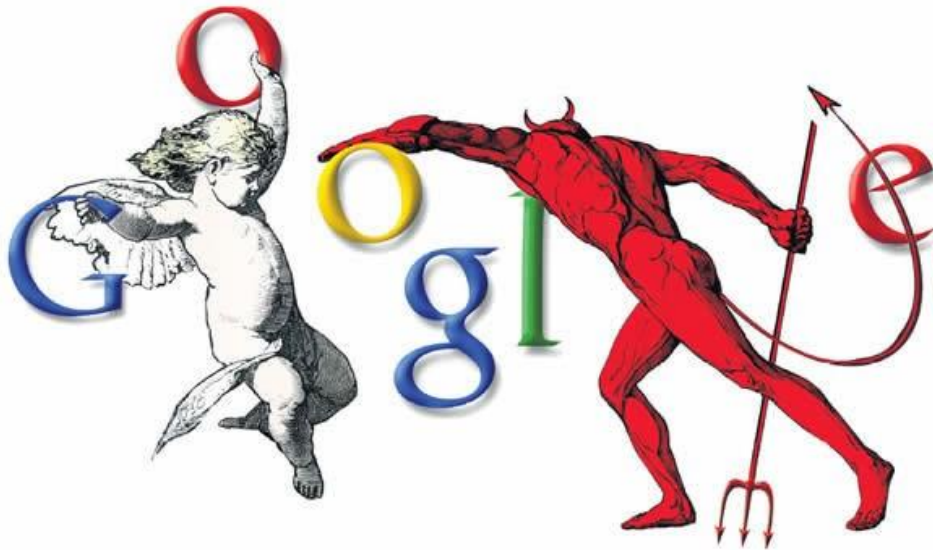

Word Formation: Conversion

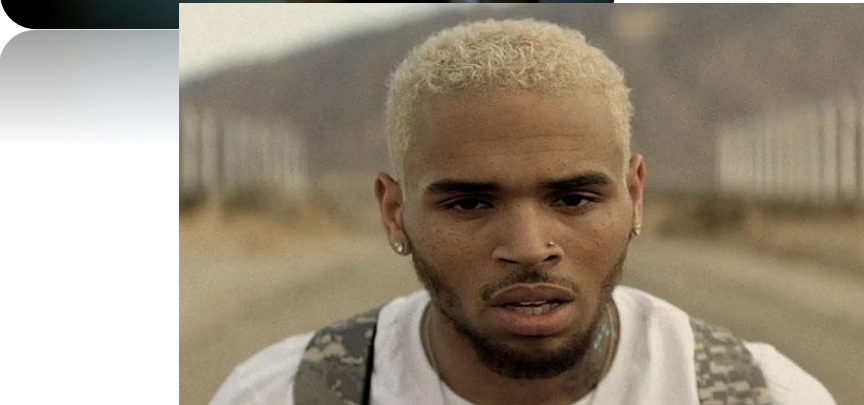
Conversion is the word formation process where by a word of one part of speech converts into a word of
