



после глагола или прилагательного

с предлогом

- **think of**

- ing form

после конструкций с глаголами **hear, listen to, notice, see, watch** и **feel** для описания незавершенного действия.

She watched her son playing with his toys. (Она наблюдала за действием в процессе.)

НО:

Для описания завершенного действия с глаголами **hear, listen to, notice, see, watch** and **feel** употребляется инфинитив без частицы **to**.

She watched her son play with his teddy bear and then put it away. (Действия были завершены.)

после прилагательных (be + adj + to V)

- happy - eager - clever

- glad - reluctant - kind

- sad - willing - polite

- be + the first / second / next / last

*He was the first man to step on the
moon.*

He's too young to see the film.

Infinitive

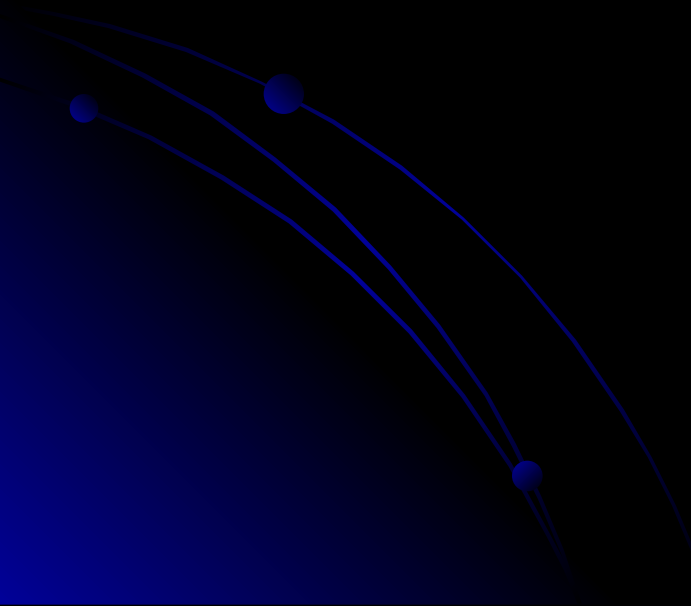
- **to tell the truth**
- **to be honest**
- **to sum up**
- **to begin with etc.**

*To tell the truth, I don't really
like her cooking.*

bare infinitive

после модальных глаголов.

Angela can type very fast.



bare infinitive

после глаголов **let, make, see, hear** и **feel**.

They won't let Georgia go to the party.

НО:

с **be made, be heard, be seen** в страдательном залоге употребляется инфинитив с частицей **to**.

He was made to clean up the mess he had created.

bare infinitive

после **had better** и **would rather** в значении «лучше бы».

Tom would rather take the bus when he goes to the city centre.

bare infinitive

после глагола **help** может употребляться как инфинитив с частицей **to**, так и без нее.

He helped his brother (to) do his homework.

+ *-ing*

+ инфинитив с частицей *to*

remember вспоминать о том, что уже произошло
Do you **remember seeing** that comedy?

помнить о том, что запланировано
Did you **remember to say** sorry to James?

forget забыть о том, что уже произошло
I'd forgotten hearing that joke.

забыть сделать то, что было запланировано
Oh, no! I forgot to invite Shelly!

stop прервать, прекратить действие
Stop crying – it's not that bad.

прервать выполнение одного действия для того, чтобы выполнить другое
I was on my way to see Maria and I stopped to get her some flowers.

try делать попытки решить проблему
Have you **tried talking** to her?

прикладывать усилие, чтобы совершить действие
I'm trying to say I'm sorry, but you won't listen!
