Dellionaire (millionaire, billionaire) a rich person whose fortune consists of having shares of Michael Dell's computer corporation

IDIOMS

It's a group of words whose meaning is different from the meaning of the individual words.

- ✓ <u>Dutch bargain</u> (дословно: голландская сделка)- сделка, в результате которой все преимущества получают лишь одна сторона.
- ✓ Marzipan layer (дословно: марципановый слой) среднее звено управления компании, которое считается лишним и не приносящим пользу ей.

IDIOMS

✓ Silver wheelchair (дословно: серебряная инвалидная коляска) крупная сумма денег, выделенная члену высшего руководства компании как компенсация за утрату должности
