



2. He was born in Moscow. He studied several foreign languages. In 1837 he was sent into the active military service in the Caucasus.




3. He was born in 1828. His farther took part in the war 1812. He created short stories for children and novels for adults. His best known work consists of four parts.






Name the Great Russian river.






This mountings are separating Europe from Asia, are an old and one of the longest mountain ranges in Russia.
