

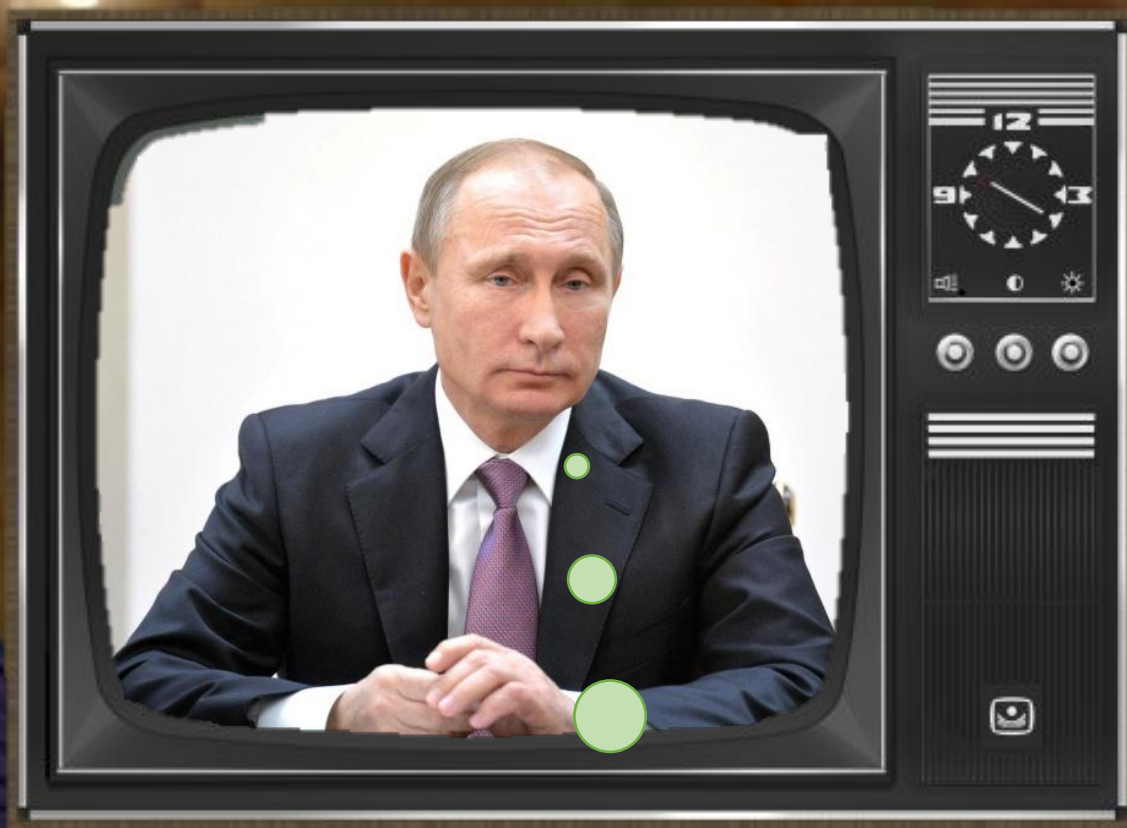
2nd or 3rd Conditional?

2nd - unreal situations about **PRESENT and FUTURE.**

If – part	Result part
If ... Past Simple ,	... would + Verb (could)

This grammar topic isn't easy at all.

If I **were** you, I **would be** more attentive *right now*.



If I **become** a president again,
I **will make** your life better.
(CONDITIONAL 1)

If I **became** a president,
I **would watch TV** in Kremlin.
(CONDITIONAL 2)

2nd or 3rd Conditional?

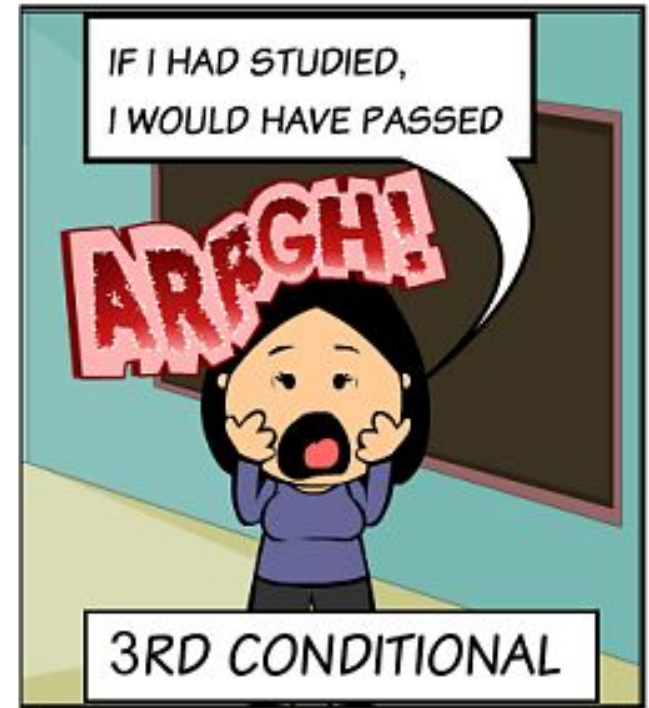
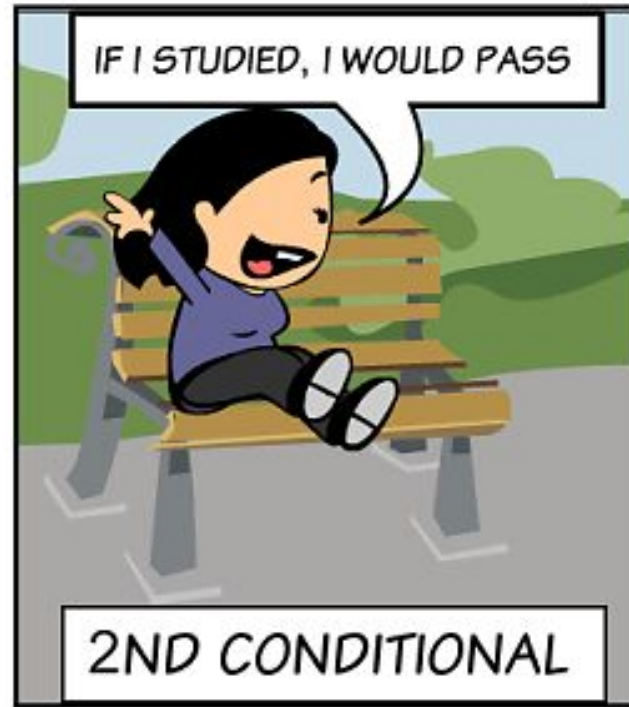
3rd

- unreal situations about **PAST**.

If – part	Result part
If ... Past Perfect ,	... would + Present Perfect (could)

Conditionals are complicated. But in the 8th form I am smart enough to get it.

If I **had started** to learn it *in the 7th form*,
I **would have gone** crazy.



2nd or 3rd Conditional?

2nd

If the book **were** shorter, I **would** **finished** it sooner.

3rd

If the book **had been** shorter, I **would** **have finished** it sooner.

2nd

If I **had** a new pair of skis, I **would** **take part** it the competition.

3rd

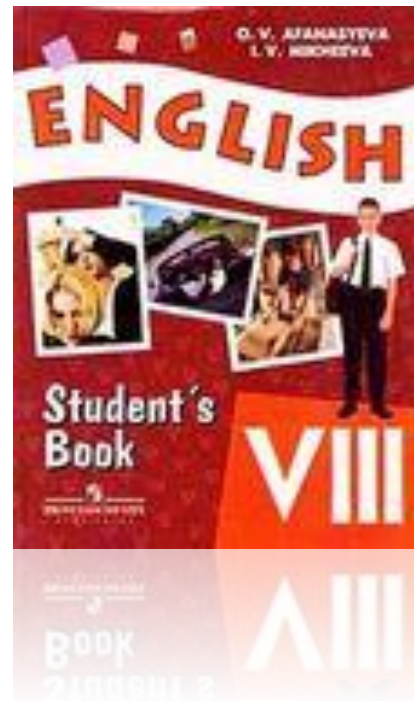
If I **had had** a new pair of skis, I **would** **have taken part** it the **competition.**
