

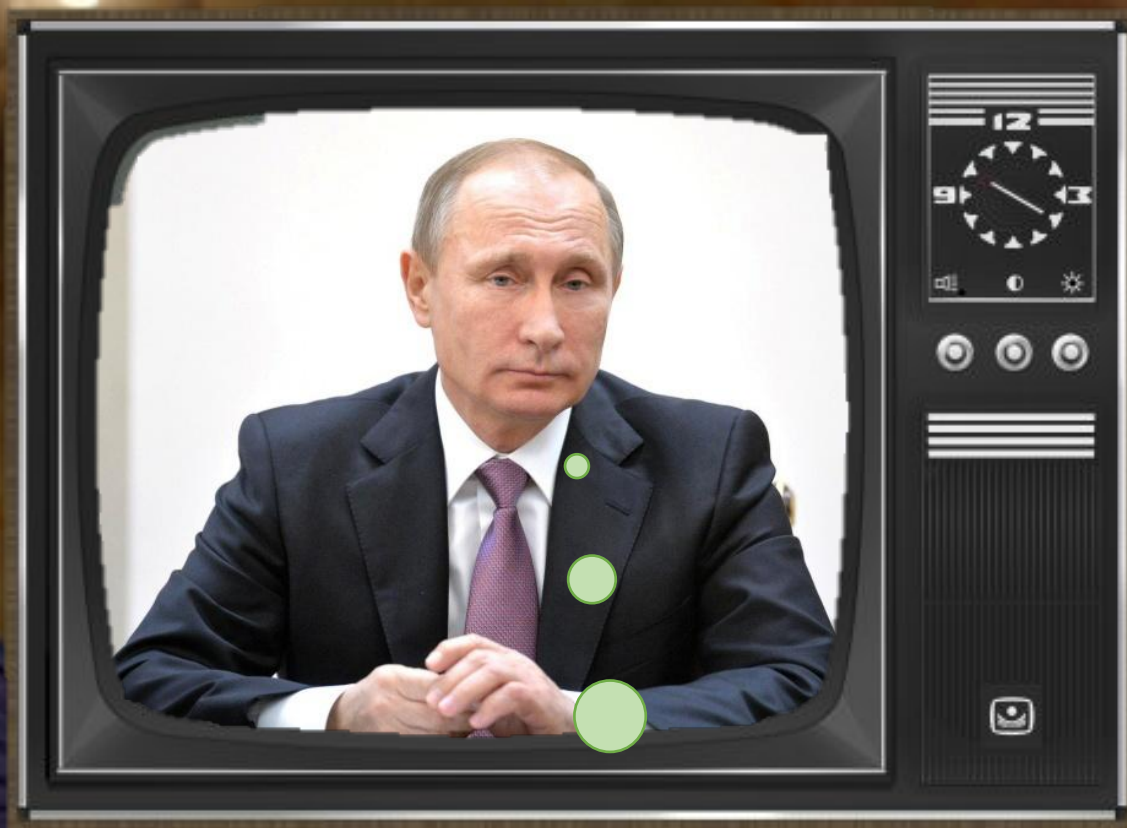
# 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Conditional?

**2nd** - unreal situations about **PRESENT and FUTURE.**

If – part	Result part
If ... <span data-bbox="698 568 991 772">Past Simple</span> ,	... <b>would</b> + <span data-bbox="1717 568 2012 772">Verb</span> <b>(could)</b>

This grammar topic isn't easy at all.

If I **were** you, I **would be** more attentive *right now*.



If I **become** a president again,  
I **will make** your life better.  
(CONDITIONAL 1)

If I **became** a president,  
I **would watch TV** in Kremlin.  
(CONDITIONAL 2)

## 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Conditional?

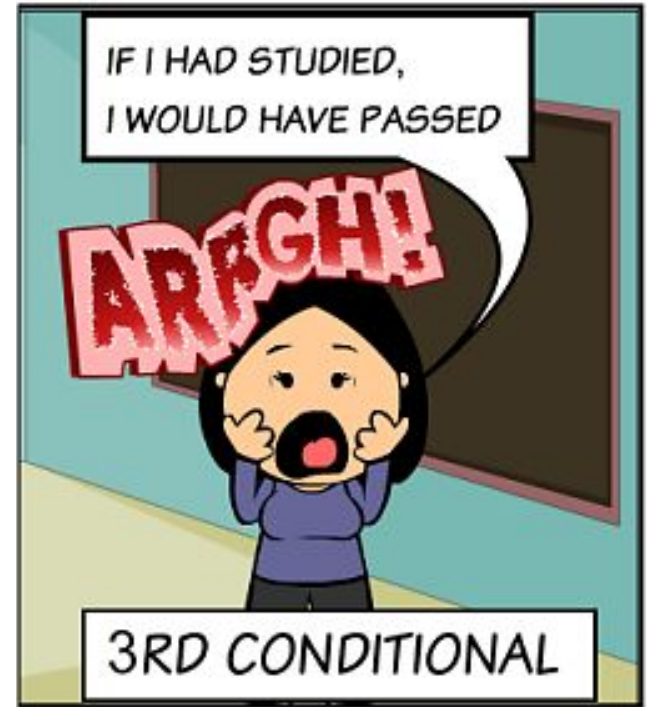
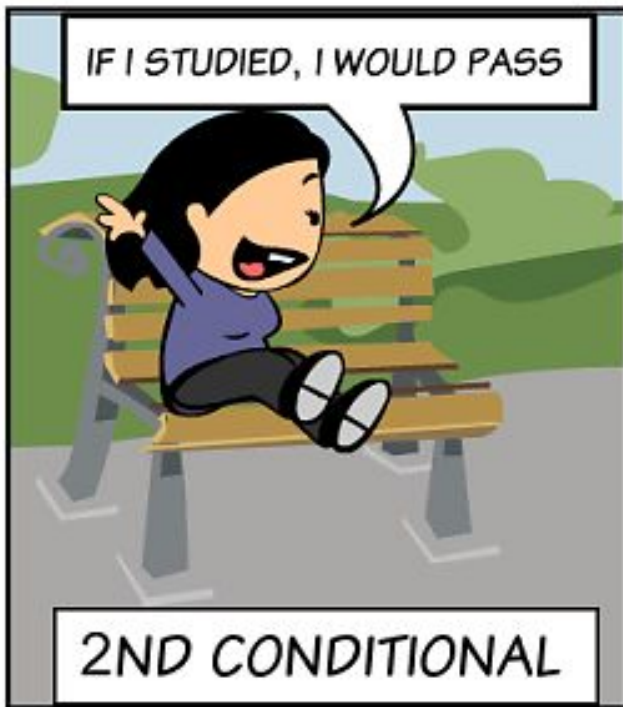
3rd

- unreal situations about **PAST**.

If – part	Result part
If ... <b>Past Perfect</b> ,	... <b>would</b> + <b>Present Perfect</b> <b>(could)</b>

Conditionals are complicated. But in the 8<sup>th</sup> form I am smart enough to get it.

If I **had started** to learn it *in the 7<sup>th</sup> form*,  
I **would have gone** crazy.



## 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Conditional?

2<sup>nd</sup>

If the book **were** shorter, I **would** **finished** it sooner.

3<sup>rd</sup>

If the book **had been** shorter, I **would** **have finished** it sooner.

2<sup>nd</sup>

If I **had** a new pair of skis, I **would** **take part** it the competition.

3<sup>rd</sup>

If I **had had** a new pair of skis, I **would** **have taken part** it the **competition.**

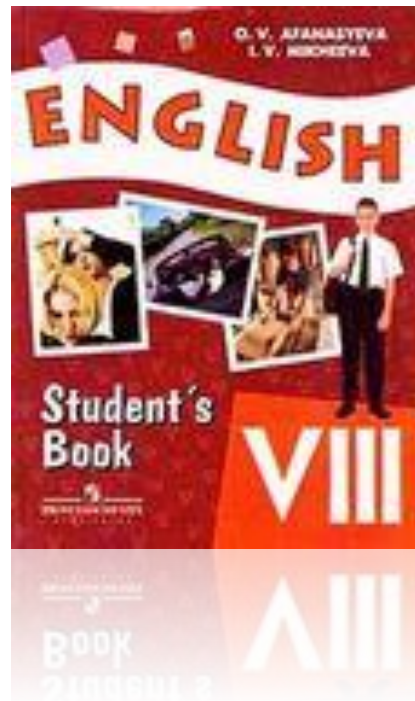
