The Aurora



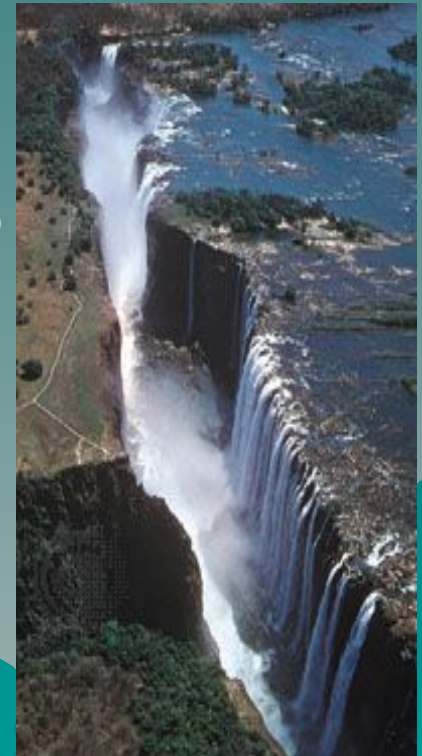

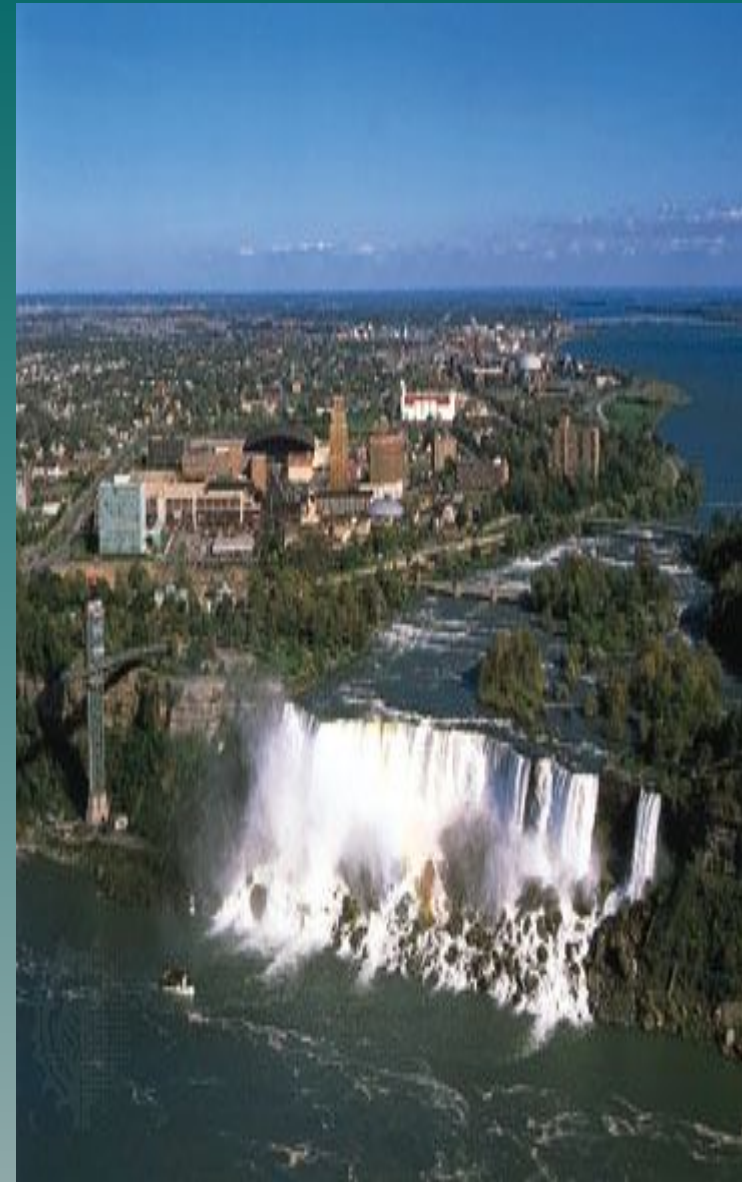
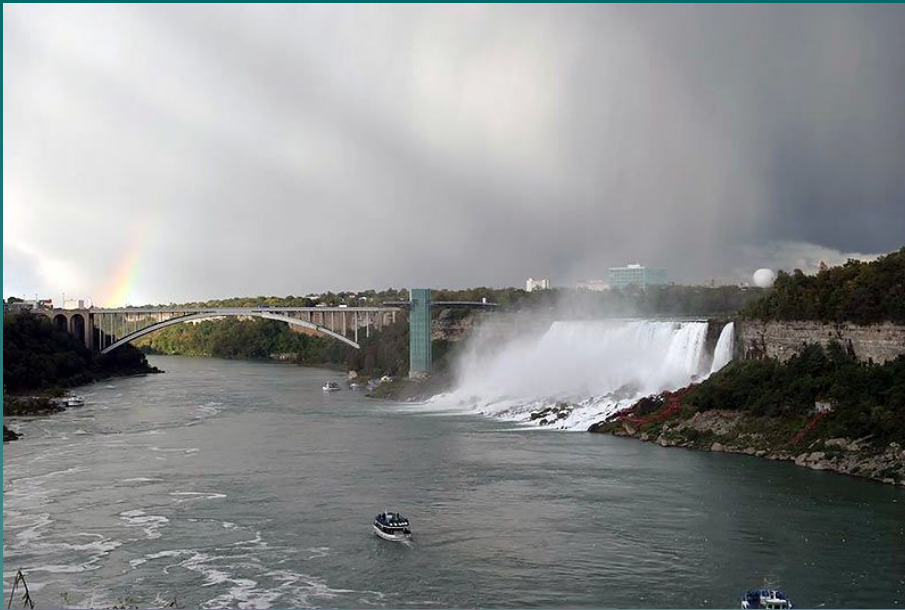


Niagara Falls
