- **The Statue of Liberty is one of the most famous symbols of America.**



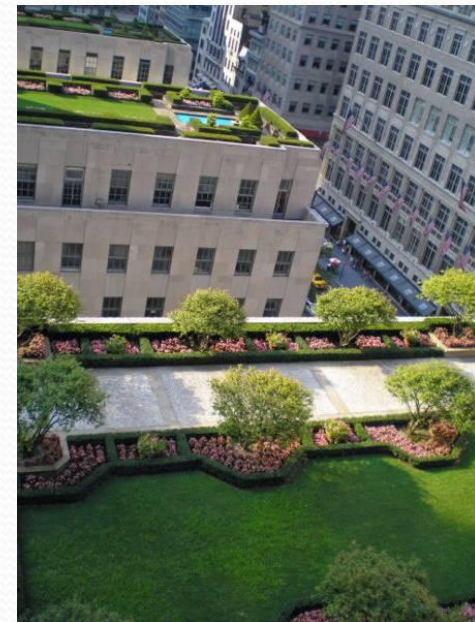
The Guggenheim Museum
