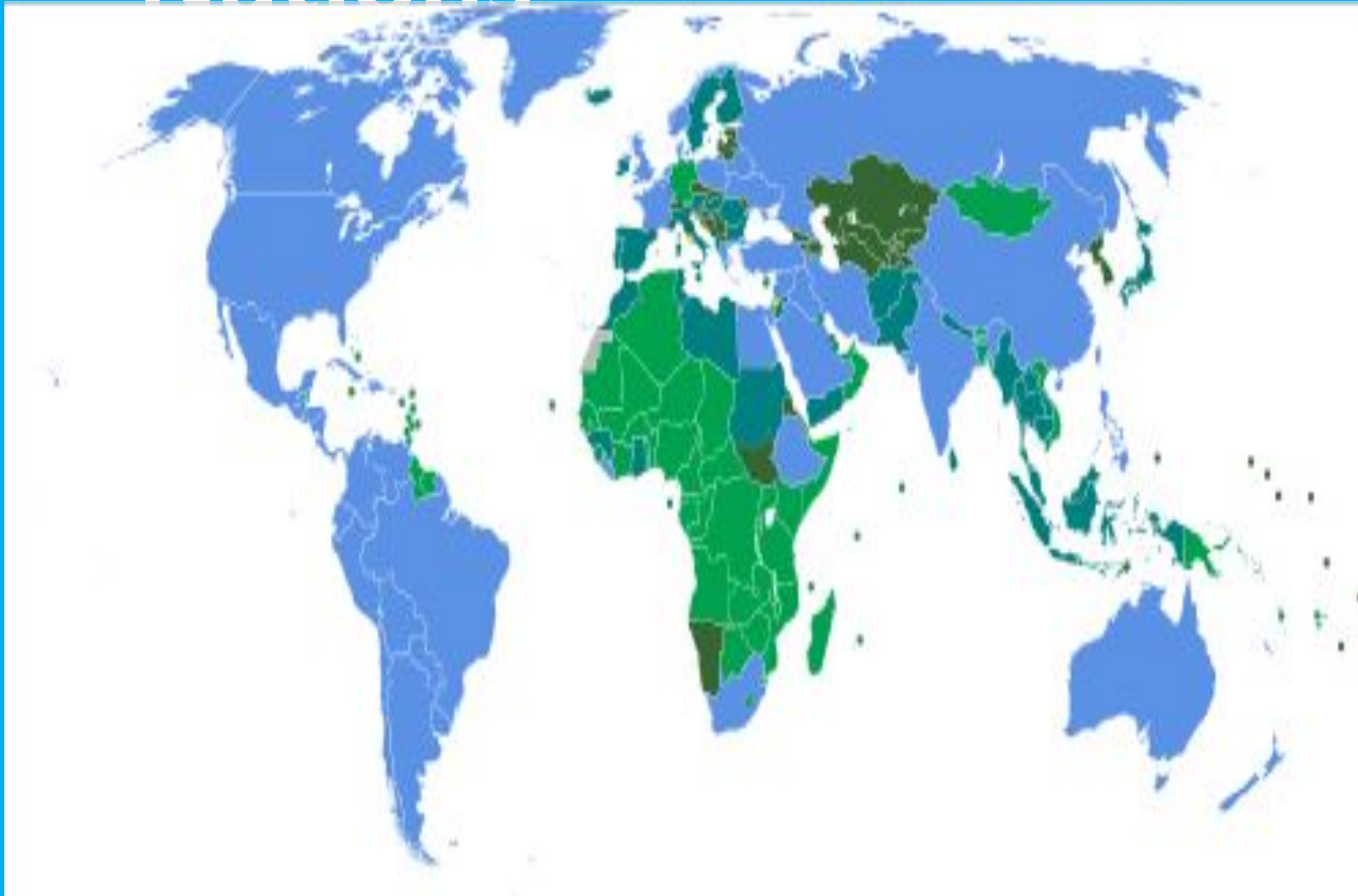
**The UN is the largest, most familiar,
