

London is a wonderful place to be! There is something for everyone. London is on the river Thames about 40 miles from the sea. London has around 7 million people living in and around it.




There are a lot of attractions in London





Houses of Parliament stand beside the river Thames.


















The Tower of London is very old. It has a long and cruel history. It is not just one building. The tall building is the White Tower, the oldest part of the Tower of London.
