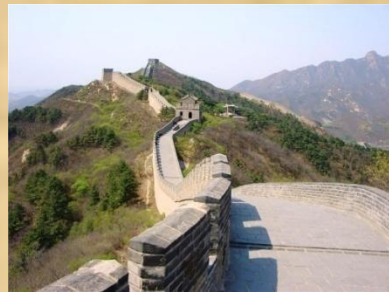


Seven Wonders of the World

The largest of the ancient Roman amphitheater and one of the most remarkable buildings in the world. Located in Rome. Construction was completed in '80.

Runs along the northern China over 6350 km.

III century BC participated in the construction of one million people.

Contrary to popular belief, space wall is not visible to the naked eye.

Christ the Redeemer statue.

The famous statue is a symbol of Rio de Janeiro and Brazil as a whole.

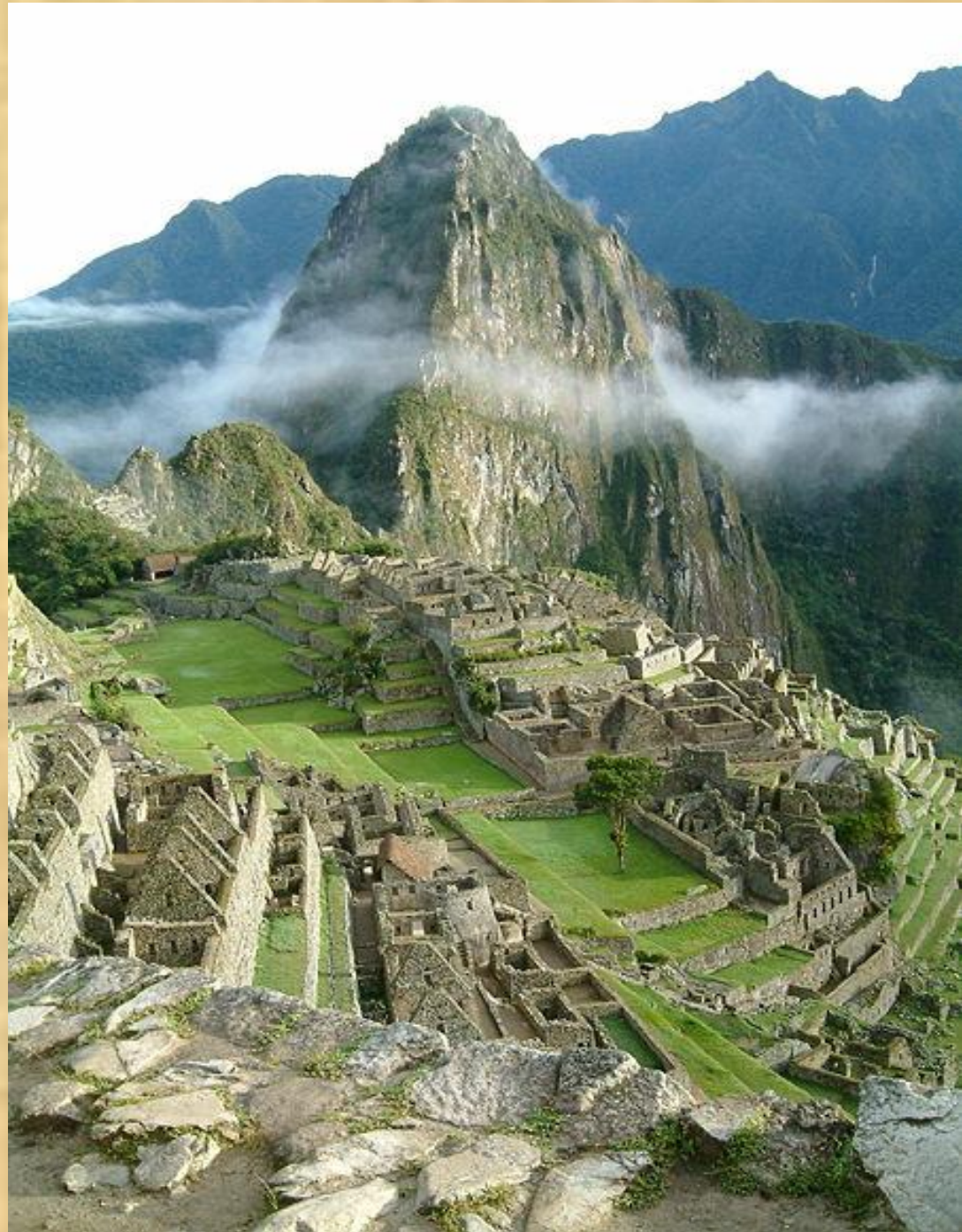
Height - 38 m, weight - 1145 tons, span - 30 meters.

disappeared.**

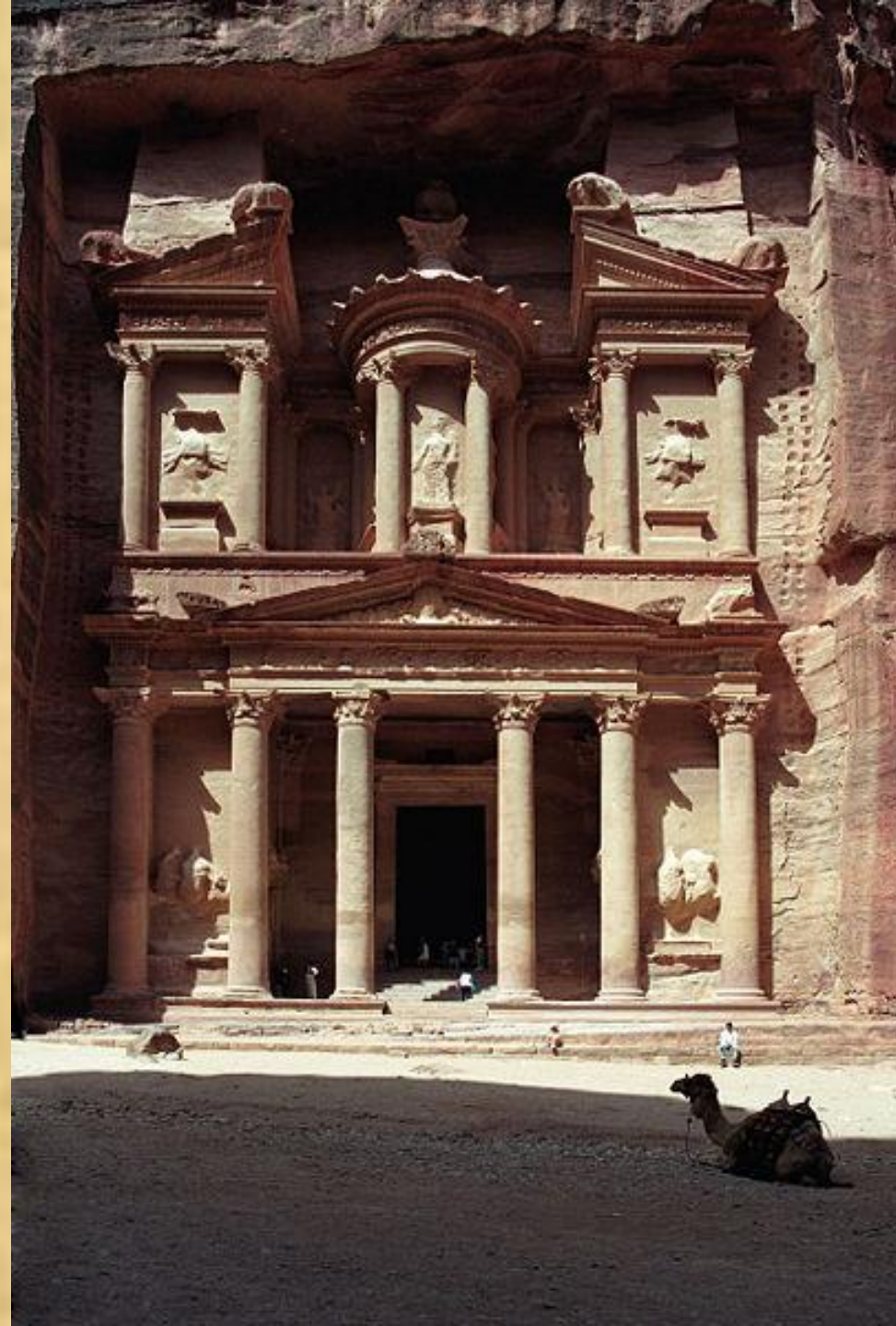
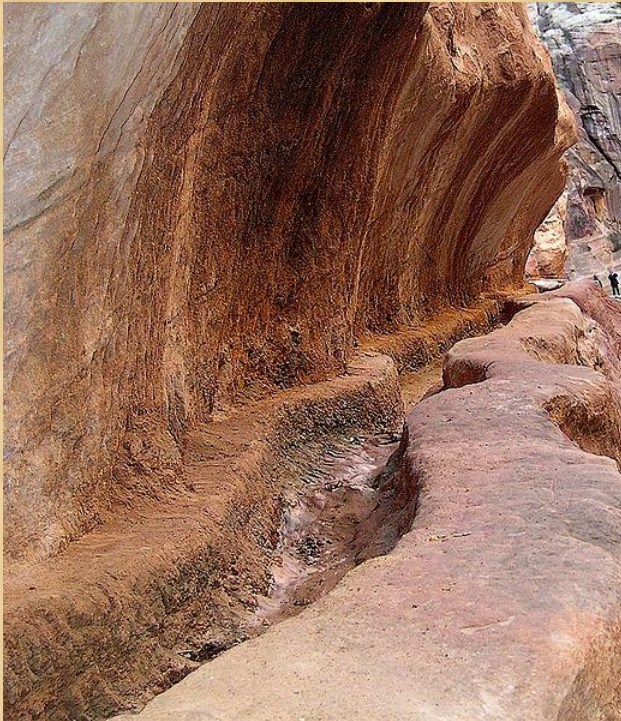
**Located on top of a
