- Para 4: feelings, closing remarks

- In the introduction you write you openings remarks and give details about the visit (when, where, who with)
- In the main body you write a general description of the place then you write what you did and saw there.
 Each paragraph should deal with a separate point.
- In the conclusion you give your final comments and feelings about your experience, then you sign off.
- A variety of adjectives are used to make the description more vivid

Strong adjectives

• Some adjectives are "base" adjectives (good, bad, angry, etc) whereas others are "strong" adjectives (fantastic, awful, furojus, etc.). We can only use absolutely to make a "strong" adjective even stronger (absolutely amazing). We can only use very with a "base" adjective (very good). We can use really with "base" or "strong" adjectives (really good, really awful)
