- **Climate change** (the high temperature on the thermometer and melting ice cap)
- **Air pollution** (the factories chimneys on the right)
- **Acid rain** (illustrated and labeled on the left)
- **Nuclear arms** (illustrated and labeled on the right)
- **Holes in the ozone layer** (shown by the melting ice cap and aerosol can and the bottom of the picture)
- **Factory accidents** (oil spillage in the sea on the left)

Acid rain

- *rain carrying acid pollutants from traffic fumes, industrial output, central heating and air conditioning .*

Ozone layer

- *the protective layer of ozone gas which blocks out the sun's harmful ultraviolet rays. CFC's (chlorofluorocarbons), which are found in aerosol sprays and refrigeration units, attack and destroy the ozone layer*

Global warming

- *the increase in temperature of the earth's atmosphere caused by the greenhouse effect*

Green effect

- *the trapping of the sun's warmth in the lower atmosphere caused by an increase in carbon dioxide and other gases, which let the heat from the sun in, but not allowed heat rising from the Earth's surface to escape.*

Overfishing

- taking too many fish, including young and female fish, from one area of the sea so that they don't reproduce and the number of fish becomes smaller and smaller.

Too little water

the countryside.**
