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Present tenses

- Simple (usually, sometimes, often, always, every day)
- Continuous (now, at the moment)



She draws every day.



She <u>is</u> draw<u>ing</u> now.



They always play toys.



They <u>are</u> play<u>ing</u> the toys now.



Interrogative forms. (?)

I <u>am</u> reading <u>now</u>. <u>Am</u> I reading now? Yes, I am. No, I am not.

He is playing the piano at the moment. Is he playing the piano at the moment? Yes, he is. No, he isn't.

We are doing homework at present. <u>Are</u> we doing homework <u>at present?</u> Yes, we are. No, we are not.



We use Present Continuous

 When we speak about an action, which is happening now (at the moment of speaking)





Look at the pictures!



The boy <u>is</u> do<u>ing</u> his homework.

The girls <u>are</u> danc<u>ing</u>.

The children <u>are</u> <u>singing.</u>







The girl <u>is playing</u> the piano.

- I <u>am</u> reading <u>now</u>.
- I <u>am</u> **not** reading <u>now</u>.
- He is playing the piano at the moment.
- He is not playing the piano at the moment.
- We are doing homework at present.
- We are **not** doing homework at present.



Remember short forms

is not = isn't am not = am not

are not = aren't




