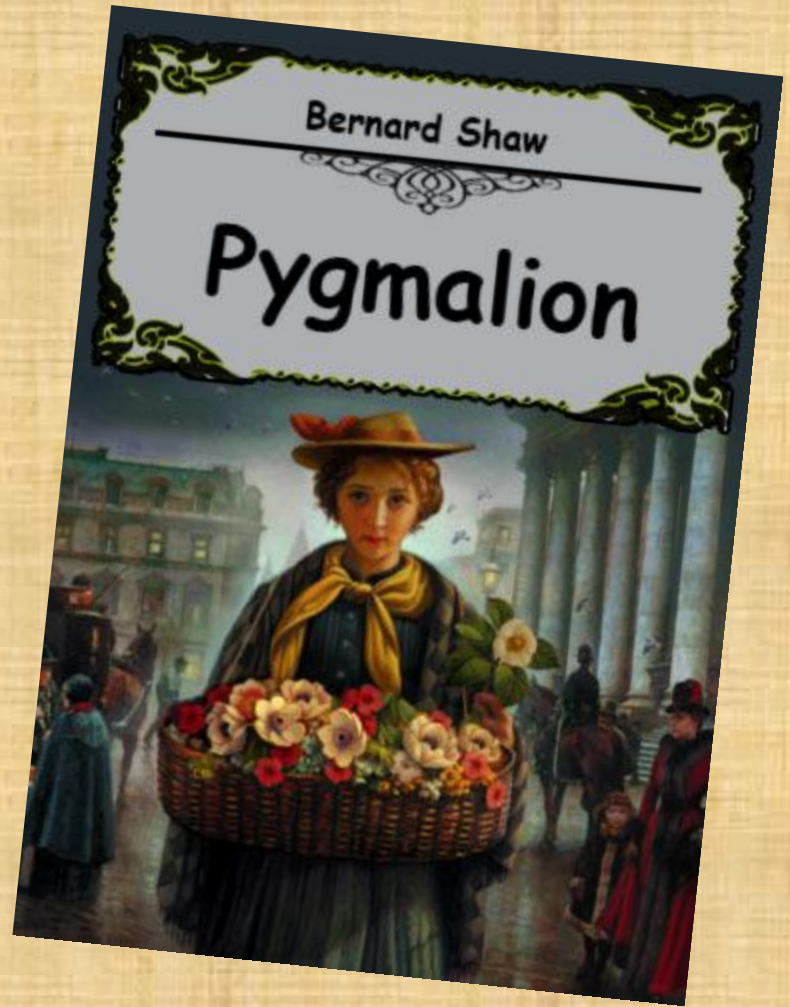
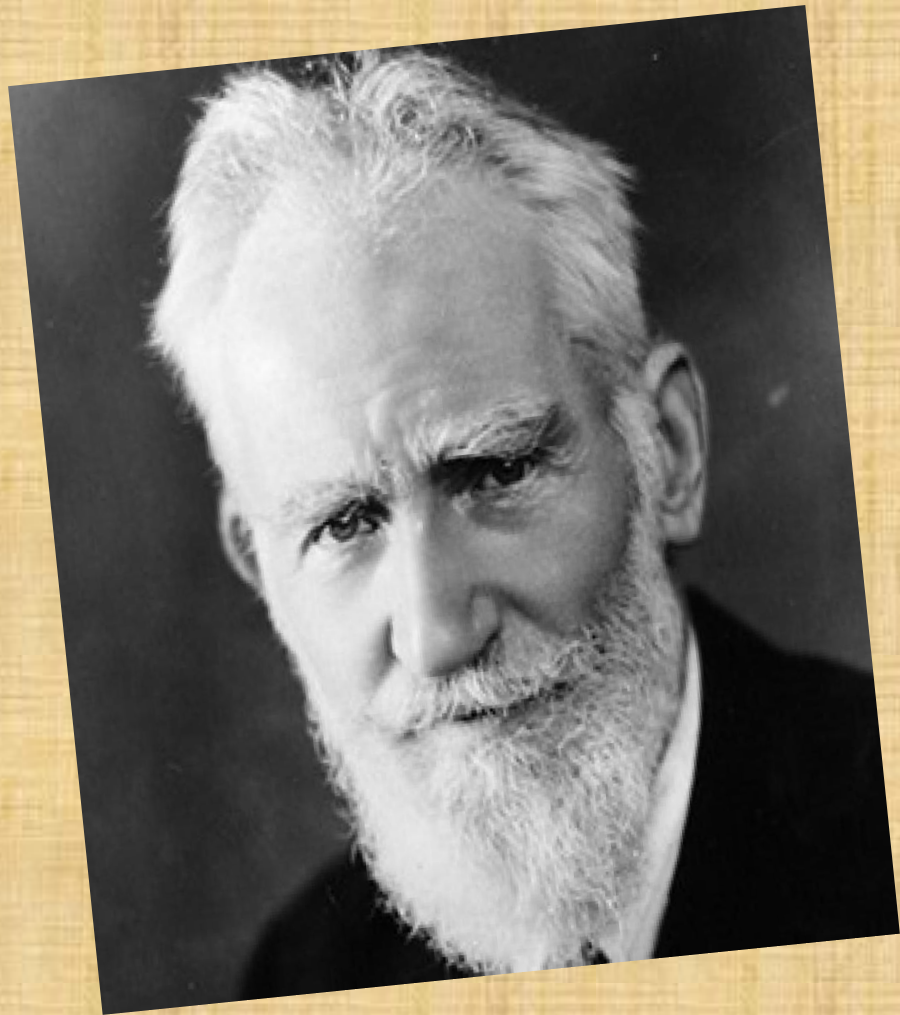


# What is Received Pronunciation? (Queen's English)
