A: What **are** the monkeys **doing** ?

B: They **are having lunch** .

They **always have lunch** at 1 o'clock.

have a bath / afternoon

A: What **are** the hippos **doing**?

B: They **are having a bath**.

They **always have a bath** in the afternoon.

play / morning

A: What **are** the dolphins **doing**?

B: They **are playing**.

They **always play** in the morning.

5. We use Present Simple for repeated actions in the present.

We use Present Continuous for actions happening at the time of speaking.

Flashwords with Present Simple:
always, usually, sometimes, on Mondays, on Tuesdays etc...once a week, twice a week, three times a week etc.



Flashwords with Present Continuous:
now, right now, at the moment.
